

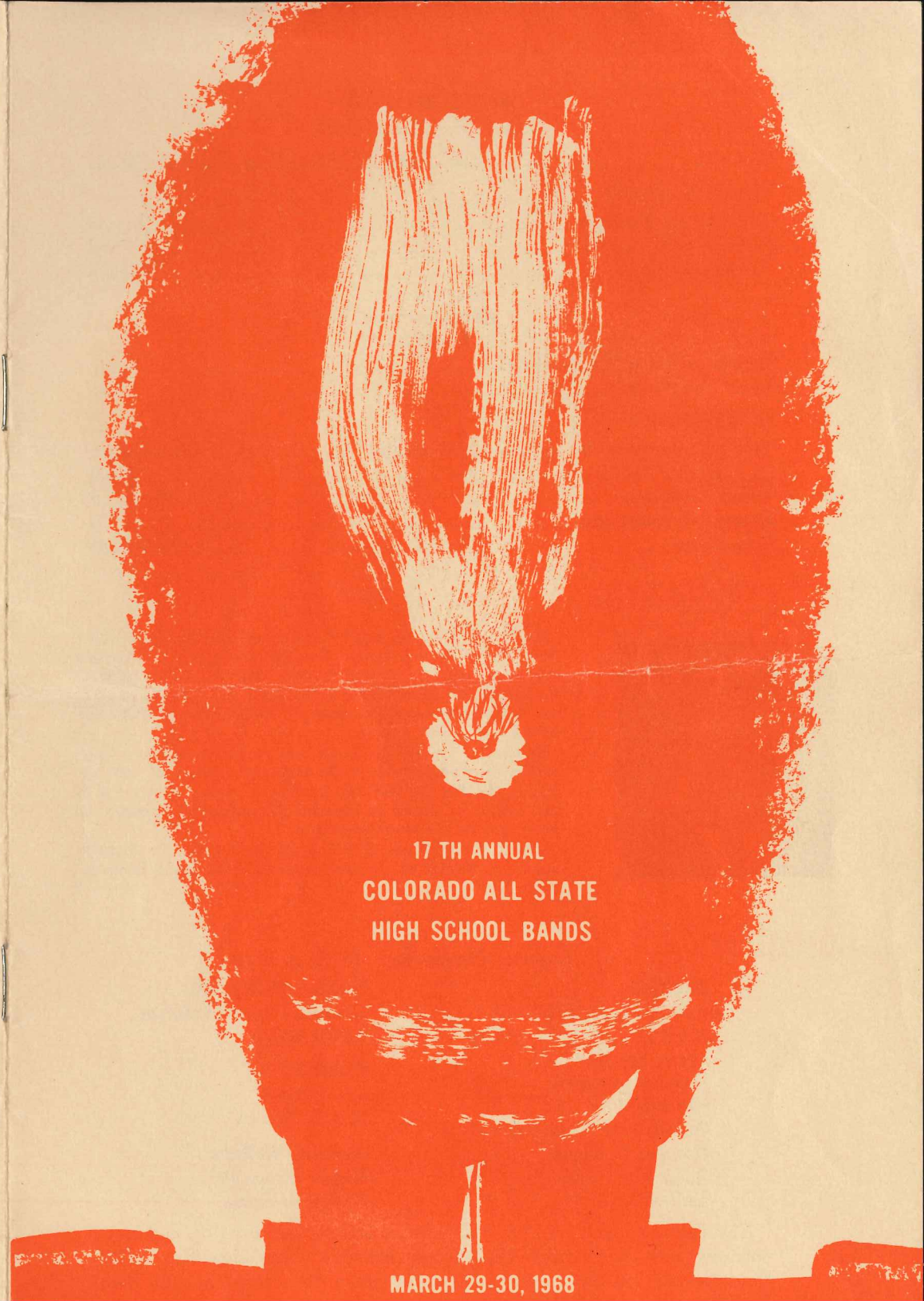

Dr. Merton Utgaard, founder and director of the International Music Camp, is well known throughout the U.S. and Canada as a music educator, adjudicator and conductor. He has had a broad background in the teaching of both vocal and instrumental music on the elementary, secondary and college levels. For the past four years he has been associated with the School of Music at Brandon University (Manitoba) as guest lecturer and music consultant.

During the summers of 1962, 1964 and 1966, Dr. Utgaard served as director of the International Music Camp European Tour Bands.
