

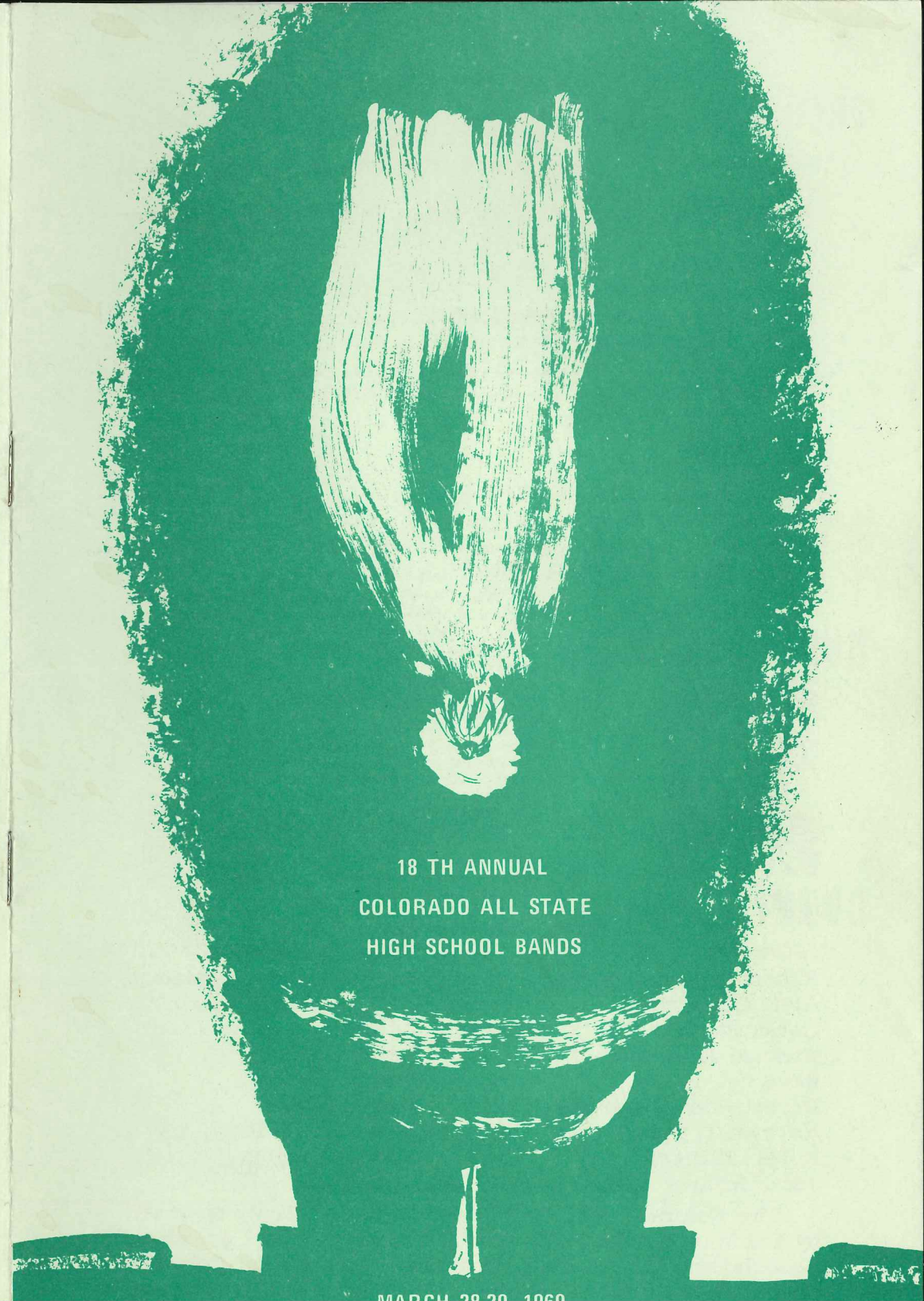

# GUEST CONDUCTOR



Robert S. Vagner, director of bands and professor of music at the University of Oregon since 1950, is noted throughout the West as a clinician, adjudicator, conductor and soloist. As a conductor, performer and teacher, Mr. Vagner has been involved in nearly all of the important 20th Century works for wind ensemble and band. He has vast knowledge of both American and European contemporary repertory and its interpretive traditions. Under Mr. Vagner's direction, the band and wind instrument program at the University of Oregon has become one of the most significant and unique programs in the nation. In this area, Mr. Vagner will be remembered for organizing the first Wyoming State Music Clinic and the first Band Camp at the University of Wyoming, and for his professional performances with the Denver Municipal Band, the Denver Symphony Orchestra, the Central City Opera and with the KOA staff orchestra.
