GUEST CONDUCTOR



Clarence Sawhill is Director of Bands at the University of California in Los Angeles, but is also known to thousands of boys and girls throughout the world as a guest conductor of music festivals. He is currently teaching in his fortieth year as a Band Director, and during this period, his work has taken him on two trips to Europe, four to Hawaii, several to Canada, and Guam, and to all of our mainland states.

Mr. Sawhill received his training at Bethany College, University of Illinois, and Northwestern University. He holds a Bachelor of Music degree, Master of Music degree and an honorary Doctor of Music degree.

In addition to teaching seventeen years at the University of California at Los Angeles, Mr. Sawhill has taught in the public schools in the midwest, ten years at the University of Illinois, five years as Director of Bands at the University of Southern California, and various summer sessions at the National Music Camp and at leading Universities as well as Colorado State College.

The band at the University of California at Los Angeles is one of the outstanding musical organizations on the west coast and was chosen to represent the United States on a good will tour in the summer of 1961, with major concerts being performed in London, Paris, Lucerne, Vienna, Munich, Copenhagen, and Aalborg, Denmark.

Pupils of Mr. Sawhill's are now successfully teaching in many colleges, universities, and public schools in our country. His concert band members have gone into leading Symphony Orchestras, Service Bands, and studio positions connected with movies, radio, television, and recording. Several of his former students are among the top composers for the Symphonic Band.

Mr. Sawhill is a past President of the College Band Directors National Association, a member of the American Bandmaster
