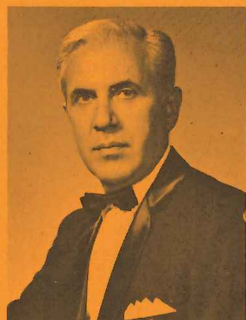

## GUEST CONDUCTOR



Harry Begian was named Director of Bands at the University of Illinois, Urbana Campus, in 1970. Immediately prior to this appointment he had been director of Bands at Michigan State University for three years. Before his work at Michigan State he had been Director of Bands at Wayne State University for three years. His work at the universities carried forward the reputation he earned during his many years at Detroit's Cass Technical High School where he developed one of the finest high school bands in the country.

During his last few years at Cass, Dr. Begian headed the Music and Performing Arts Departments.

Begian organized and conducted his first band and orchestra while in his late teens and has studied conducting at Tanglewood, summer home of the Boston Symphony Orchestra. He has appeared as guest conductor, adjudicator, clinician, and lecturer throughout the United States and Canada. Along with a very busy work schedule, he has found time to conduct operatic and Broadway performances, community symphony orchestras, community concert bands, and a church choir.
