GUEST CONDUCTOR

H. Robert Reynolds is Director of Bands and Professor of Music at The University of Michigan. An Alumnus of the University, he holds degrees in music education and Wind instruments.

He began his university conducting career at California State University at Long Beach, and received the Gold Award of Recognition from the Southern California School Band and Orchestra Association. From 1968-1975 he was Director of Bands at the University of Wisconsin.

Professor Reynolds has won the praise of composers Aaron Copland, Darius Milhaud, Gunther Schuller, Karel Husa and many others for his interpretive conducting of their compositions. Each month he reviews the most recent band compositions for The Instrumentalist, and is on the editorial board of the Journal of Band Research. He is the author of numerous articles also.

Professor Reynolds is currently Divisional President of the College Band Directors National Association. He has conducted in distinguished concert halls nationally, and has lectured at national conferences and leading universities about the conducting and analysis of masterpieces of the band and wind ensemble repertoire.
