## FRANK L. BATTISTI

Frank L. Battisti is conductor of the New England Conservatory Wind Ensemble. Under Mr. Battisti's leadership the Ensemble has established a national reputation for being one of the premier ensembles of its kind in the United States. He has conducted wind ensembles and bands at Ithaca High School (Ithaca, New York) where his high school band earned a national reputation through its continuous high level of performance at major music conferences and for its unique commissioning works project. From 1958-67 the Ithaca High School Band and Mr. Battisti commissioned and premiered twenty-four works by major contemporary composers. From 1967-1969 Mr. Battisti was conductor of the Baldwin-Wallace College Symphonic Wind Ensemble. He was appointed to the faculty of the New England Conservatory in 1969.

In 1970 Mr. Battisti organized the Massachusetts Youth Wind Ensemble, and in 1970-71 he was visiting conductor of the Harvard University Concert Band and conducted them in their first Lincoln Center Concert.

Mr. Battisti was appointed Chairman of the Music Education Department of the New England Conservatory in 1970, a position he still holds. He also teaches conducting.

Mr. Battisti is president of the College Band Directors National Association. He is also the founder of the National Wind Ensemble Conference and a member of the Serious Music Award Panel for ASCAP. Also listed in Who's Who in America and the International Biographical Dictionary of Musicians.

Over the years Mr. Battisti has contributed many articles to journals and magazines regarding the literature of music for wind ensembles and bands. He is considered one of the foremost authorities on wind music literature.
