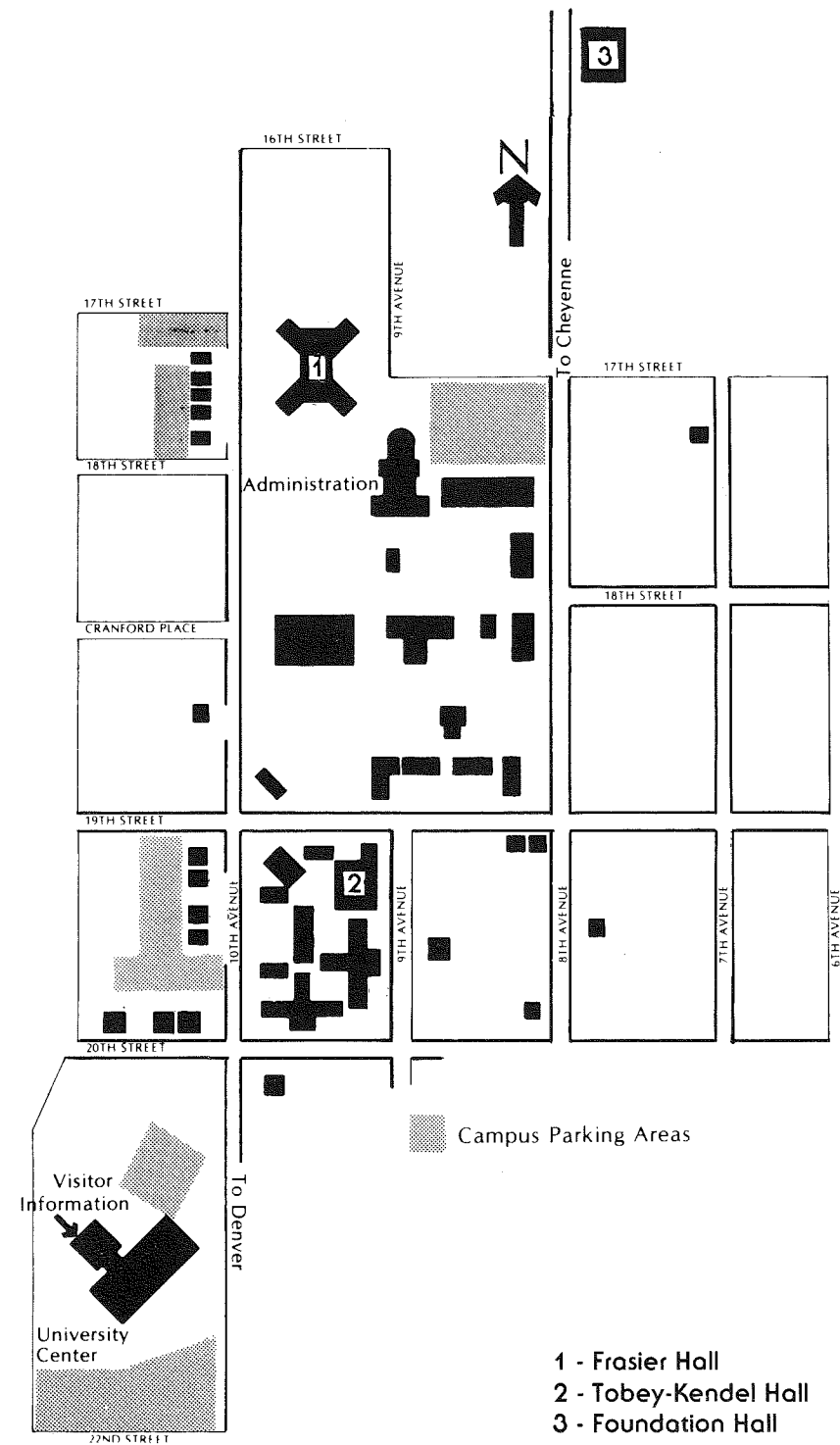

**MEET YOUR 1983
CELEBRITY CONDUCTOR**

Frederick Fennell, known as the "Father of the Wind Ensemble," is one of the nation's best-known conductors. His rare musical personality is uniquely American, reflecting in depth both the exemplary achievements of our educational process and the highest standards in American professional performance. Professor Fennell's many Mercury recordings of orchestral, wind ensemble, and band music (currently being released as Mercury Golden Imports) grant him presence in the private musical life of listeners everywhere. His affectionate regard for young musicians as well as his concern for the serious business of their training is coupled with consummate technical knowledge and vast professional experience.

Following a long and distinguished career at Rochester's Eastman School of Music, where he founded the Eastman Wind Ensemble, Dr. Fennell served as Associate Music Director of the Minneapolis Symphony Orchestra, later moving to Florida as Conductor-in-Residence at the University of Miami, where he was named Professor Emeritus in 1980. He is one of the most provocative, influential, and busy conductors of our time.

In the July 1977 issue of *Stereo Review*, Editor David Hall selected the Fennell/Eastman Wind Ensemble recording of Percy Grainger's *Lincolnshire Posy* as one of "the Fifty Best Recordings of the Centenary of the Phonograph: 1877-1977." Frederick Fennell then began the phonograph's second century with an "historic first U.S. recording," using the digital tape recorder in a new series of discs for TELARC RECORDS played by The Cleveland Symphonic Winds.

Dr. Fennell has recently accepted the position of "regular conductor" of the Tokyo Kosei Wind Orchestra. It is a full-time position with a nine-month season that he will begin in December, 1983.

Recent concert travels have taken him to such diverse cities as Oslo, Norway; Oakland, California; Honolulu, Hawaii, and Tokyo, Japan. A recent reviewer has aptly described Frederick Fennell as "... a bundle of energy wrapped in warmth." We are pleased to welcome Frederick Fennell as our guest celebrity for the Second Annual Celebrity Symposium in Music at the University of Northern Colorado.

UNIVERSITY BANDS

WIND ENSEMBLE — The Wind Ensemble, the first of six groups within the Band Department, is an assemblage of the most outstanding wind and percussion majors in the University of Northern Colorado School of Music. Using the player pool concept, the Ensemble performs a repertoire ranging from works requiring as few as ten players to as many as seventy. Flexible instrumentation and player rotation provide members of the ensemble with a variety of responsibilities, challenges and playing experiences.

The Wind Ensemble has appeared at the Southwestern Music Educators Conference, the Colorado Music Educators Association Convention, and the College Band Directors National Association National Convention in Ann Arbor, Michigan. A recording of the Ann Arbor performance is available through Crest Records. In addition, the Ensemble has released four other albums, **New Directions**, **Spheres of Influence**, **Omnibus** and **Reflections**. The Ensemble has also been featured on the National Public Radio Program, **Windworks**.

SYMPHONY BAND — The Symphony Band is an organization of approximately eighty musicians selected from the finest performers on campus. Although most members are music majors, students specializing in other fields often qualify for this ensemble through audition.

Literature for the band is drawn from the finest contemporary and traditional repertoire. Players in this group are afforded the opportunity to perform in flexible-size ensembles which are determined by the composers' concepts of instrumentation and timbre. This highly skilled band maintains an active performance and recording schedule throughout the year.
