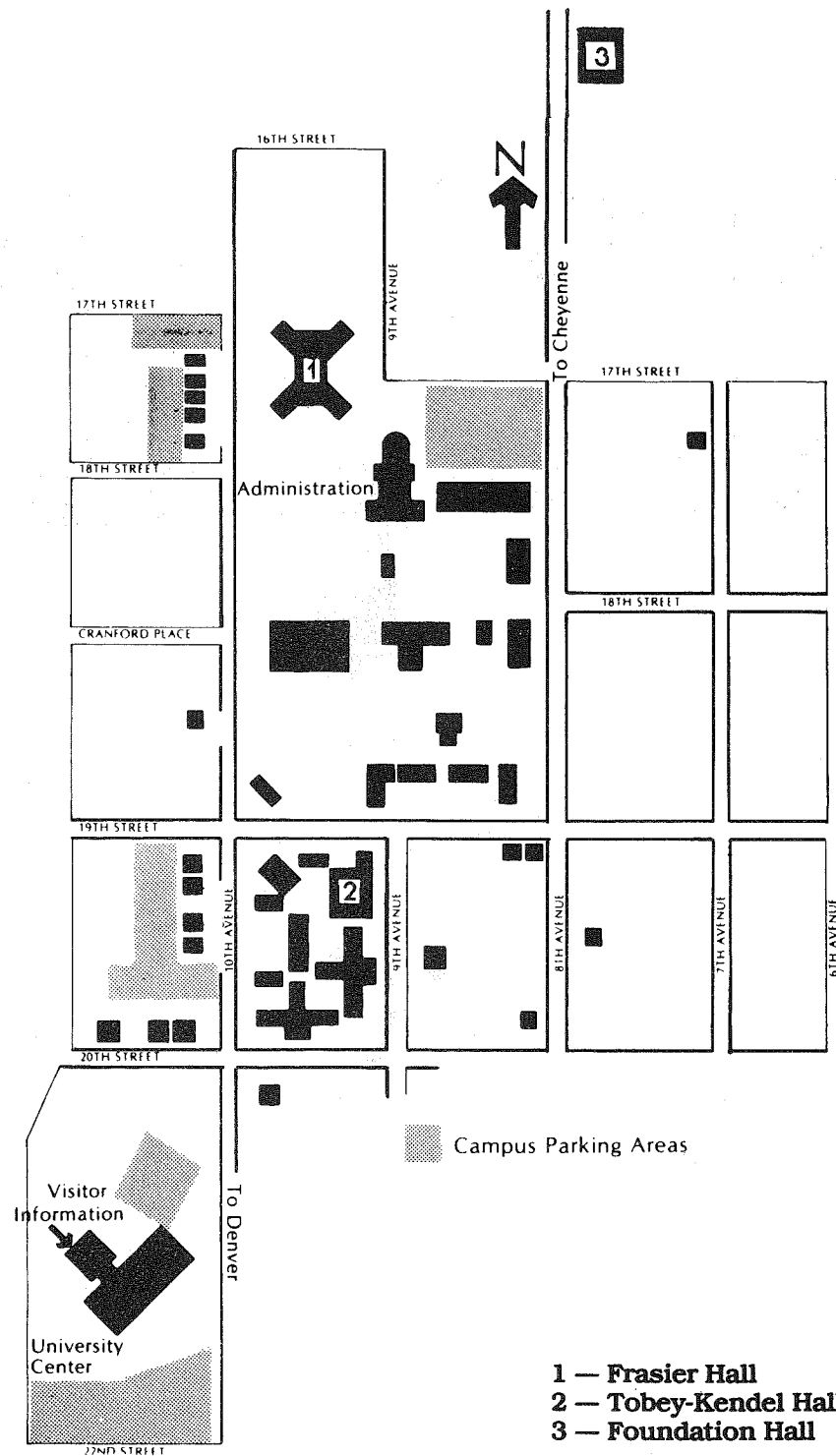

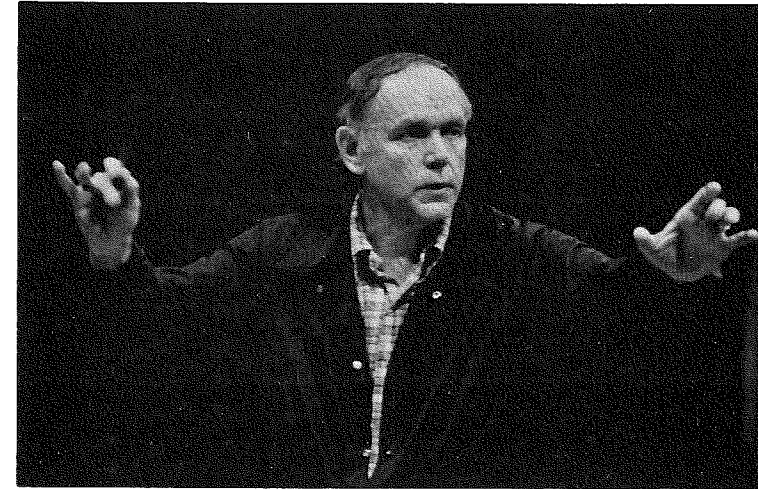

MEET YOUR 1985 CELEBRITY CONDUCTOR

Frank L. Battisti, one of the foremost authorities on wind music literature, is conductor of the New England Conservatory Wind Ensemble. Under Mr. Battisti's leadership, the Ensemble has established a national reputation as one of the premier ensembles of its kind in the United States. He has conducted wind ensembles and bands at Ithaca (New York) High School, where his high school band earned a national reputation through its continuously high level of performance at major music conferences and for its unique project for commissioning new works.

From 1958-1967, the Ithaca High School Band and Mr. Battisti commissioned and premiered twenty-four works by major contemporary composers. From 1967-1969, Mr. Battisti was conductor of the Baldwin-Wallace College Symphonic Wind Ensemble. He was appointed to the faculty of the New England Conservatory in 1969.

In 1970, Mr. Battisti organized the Massachusetts Youth Wind Ensemble, and was appointed Chairman of the Music Education Department of the New England Conservatory, a position he still holds. He also teaches conducting. In 1970-1971, he was visiting conductor of the Harvard University Concert Band and conducted in their first Lincoln Center Concert.

Past president of the College Band Directors National Association, Mr. Battisti also is the founder of the National Wind Ensemble Conference and a member of the Serious Music Award Panel for the American Society of Composers, Authors and Publishers. Mr. Battisti is listed in *Who's Who in America* and the *International Biographical Dictionary of Musicians*. Through the years, Mr. Battisti has contributed many articles to journals and magazines regarding the literature of music for wind ensembles and bands.

UNIVERSITY BANDS

The Band Program at the University of Northern Colorado draws upon a rich and well-founded tradition of excellence and has developed into a program that has received national recognition. The UNC Wind Ensemble has been invited to perform for numerous state and national conventions, including the 1985 College Band Directors National Association Convention. Recent recordings by the Wind Ensemble enjoy wide acclaim, with the most current release available on the Composers Voice Series through the Donemus Foundation, Amsterdam.

WIND ENSEMBLE -- The Wind Ensemble is comprised of 47 of the University's finest wind and percussion majors. Flexible instrumentation and player rotation provide members of the ensemble an opportunity to perform the most challenging works from today's wind repertoire.

SYMPHONY BAND -- The Symphony Band, an ensemble of 70 performers, draws upon the wealth of traditional and contemporary literature available for band.

CONCERT BAND -- The Concert Band, designed to encourage participation from the entire University community, provides a high quality musical experience for both music majors and non-majors.

SUMMER SYMPHONIC BAND AND WIND ENSEMBLE -- The Summer Symphonic Band and

Wind Ensemble, integral components of the UNC Summer Festival of the Arts for past 50 years, perform weekly outdoor concerts in UNC's Garden Theatre.

THE COLLEGE OF PERFORMING AND VISUAL ARTS at UNC maintains an annual calendar of more than 300 cultural events, including exhibits, dance concerts, operas, musicals, recitals, and concerts, both traditional and contemporary. More than 50 full-time faculty members serve approximately 600 majors within the College.

THE SCHOOL OF MUSIC serves 400 majors and offers more than 30 performance ensembles in addition to opportunities for solo vocal and instrumental experience. UNC performance groups are regionally and nationally recognized, and UNC graduates are found in prestigious performance and educational positions nationwide.

In addition to undergraduate degrees in music education and performance, the School of Music offers masters and doctoral degrees in many academic and performance areas, including conducting. The University of Northern Colorado is an accredited institutional member of the National Association of Schools of Music. The School of Music also is accredited by the National Council for the Accreditation of Teacher Education and the Colorado Department of Education for all K-12 programs in music.
