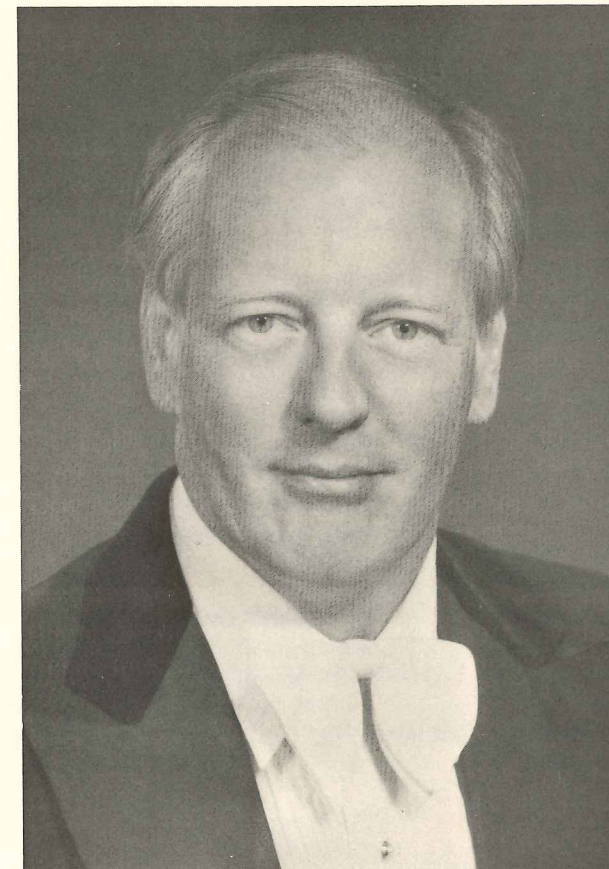

Dr. Thomas Lee

Thomas Lee, who holds the Doctor of Musical Arts degree in Conducting, is Director of Bands and Professor of Music at the University of California at Los Angeles, where he conducts the UCLA Wind Ensemble and directs the graduate program in Band Conducting.

Before moving to UCLA, Dr. Lee was Professor of Music at the University of Texas, Austin, where he was conductor of the Wind Ensemble. Prior to that, he was conductor of bands at Ohio University in Athens, Ohio, where he was awarded a University Research Grant for the development of an innovative method for teaching conducting. In addition, he instituted a program of commissioning new works by American composers, culminating in the first such premiere at the Kennedy Center in Washington, D. C.

After earning his bachelor's and master's degrees at Drake University, Lee was appointed head of the music department at Dowling High School in Des Moines, Iowa, as well as supervisor of the Des Moines Catholic Elementary Music program. While in college, Dr. Lee was drum major of the Drake University Marching Band, played tuba with the Concert Band, and sang with several Drake and Cincinnati choral ensembles. He also performed with the Des Moines Symphony and sang with St. Paul's Boys Choir.

Dr. Lee's training, both at Drake University and at the Cincinnati College-Conservatory of Music (where he received his doctorate), included several distinguished and influential teachers, including Don Marcouiller at Drake and both Elmer Thomas and Robert Hornyak at Cincinnati.

Dr. Lee has been invited to be guest conductor with All-State Bands and music festivals throughout the U. S. A. and Canada. In Addition, he has given workshops on all aspects of conducting and music interpretation.
