All-State Band Clinicians



Dr. Kenneth Singleton

Kenneth Singleton has been director of bands at the University of Northern Colorado since June 1985. He has also taught at New Mexico State University (Las Cruces), the Hartt School of Music (University of Hartford), Albertus Magnus College and Yale University, both in New Haven, Connecticut. Singleton holds a degree from the University of South Florida and a doctorate from Yale University.

He is an avid transcriber of brass music (more than 1,000 titles) and a music editor for the Charles Ives Society. Since his arrival in Greeley he has completed a number of transcriptions for band, including Tchaikovsky's complete **Symphony No. 2**, Ives' **Postlude in F**, and Shostakovich's **Golden Age Ballet Suite**.

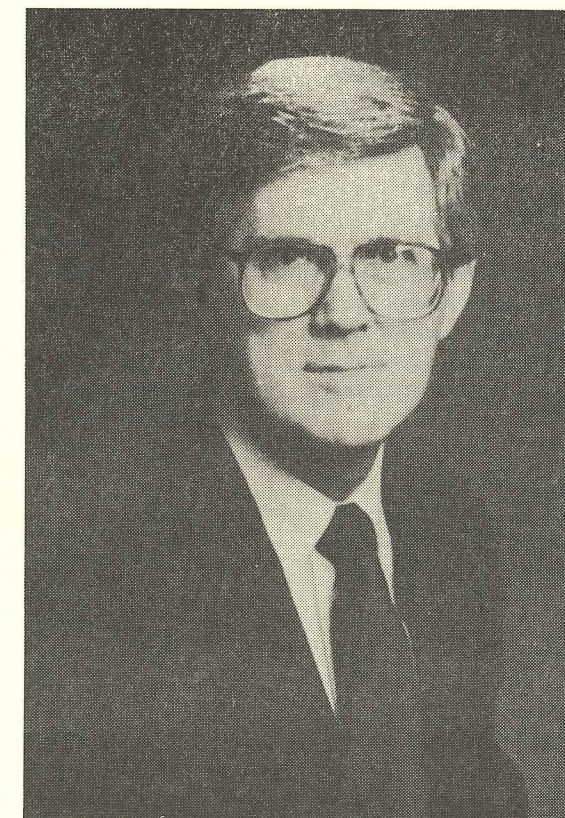
Dr. Singleton is in constant demand as a guest clinician, recently conducting numerous honor bands in the Colorado area as well as Orchestra New England, the University of Arizona Wind Ensemble, and the New Mexico All-State Concert Band.

Dr. James Croft

James Croft is director of bands at Florida State University in Tallahassee, a position he has held since 1980. He has also been director of bands at the University of South Florida in Tampa, Oshkosh (Wisconsin) High School, and Traer (Iowa) High School. He holds degrees from Cornell College, the University of Northern Iowa, and a doctorate from the University of Oklahoma. Dr. Croft conducts the Wind Orchestra and Symphonic Band at FSU. He is also professor of conducting and directs doctoral research.

Dr. Croft is a member of the American Bandmasters Association and is president of the National Band Association. He is also president-elect of the Southern Division of the College Band Directors National Association.

Dr. Croft has conducted All-State and Honor Bands throughout the country, and is one of the most popular band conductors on the international scene. Since last May he has conducted the Hungarian Central Army Wind Orchestra, the Israel National Youth Band, The British National Association of Symphonic Bands and Wind Ensembles (Manchester, England), and bands in Melbourne, Australia.
