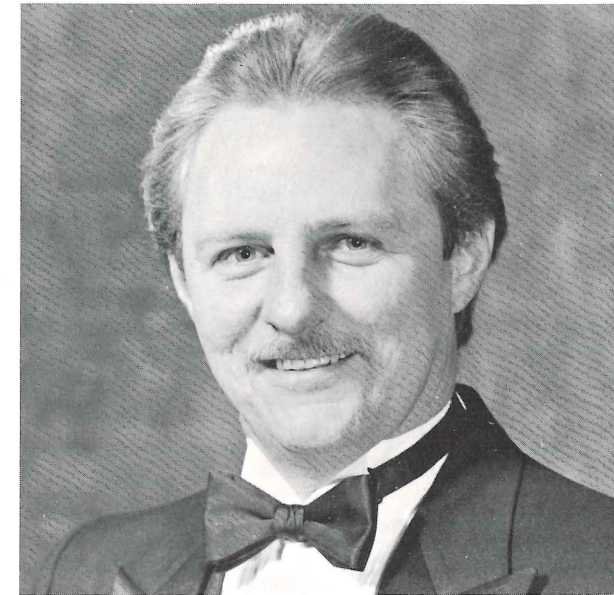
All-State Band Clinicians

Eddie R. Smith

Eddie R. Smith, Director of Bands at the University of Wyoming, received the Master of Arts degree from the University of South Florida, and the Bachelor of Music Education and Doctor of Philosophy degrees from Florida State University, where he also served as Assistant Director of Bands.

Dr. Smith taught for more than ten years in the public and parochial school systems of Florida, and was selected as "Jazz Educator of the Year" in 1979 by the Florida division of the National Association of Jazz Educators. He has also been director of the Third U. S. Army Jazz Band.

He is an active member of the Music Educators National Conference, State Chairman of the College Band Directors National Association, Wyoming State Chairman of the National Band Association, Research Chairman of the Wyoming Music Educators Association, and Governor of the Mid-West District of Kappa Kappa Psi.



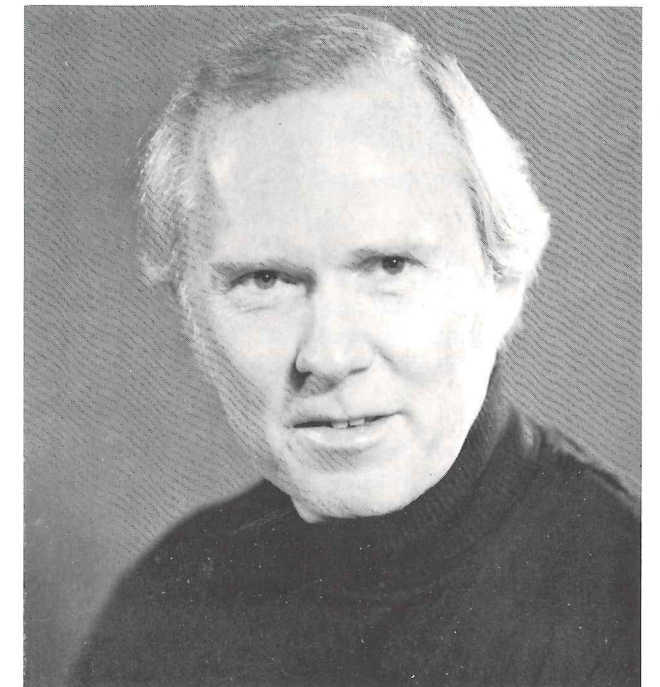
H. Robert Reynolds

H. Robert Reynolds is Director of Bands and Chairman of the Conducting Department at the University of Michigan. He has conducted in Lincoln Center (New York), Orchestra Hall (Chicago), Kennedy Center (Washington, D. C.), Powell Symphony Hall (St. Louis), the Academy of Music (Philadelphia), and has conducted an opera for La Scala Opera in Milan, Italy.

In addition to his frequent appearances throughout the United States, he was a featured lecturer at the International Conference for Symphonic Bands and Ensembles in Norway (1983) and Belgium (1985). He is Past President of the College Band Directors National Association.

Often the conductor of premiere performances, Reynolds has won praise from composers such as Aaron Copland, Karlheinz Stockhausen, Darius Milhaud, and Gunther Schuller for his interpretive conducting of their compositions. He is musical advisor and conductor of the Detroit Chamber Winds, a professional wind ensemble drawn largely from the ranks of the Detroit Symphony Orchestra.

Reynolds holds degrees in Music Education and Performance from the University of Michigan, where he was a conducting student of Elizabeth Green.
