All-State Band Clinicians

John R. Bell



Dr. John R. Bell is Associate Director of Bands and Director of the "Pride of the Rockies" Marching Band at the University of Northern Colorado, where he also conducts the Symphonic Band, and teaches conducting, arranging and music education courses.

Dr. Bell received his Bachelor of Music Education degree from Louisiana State University, and master's and doctoral degrees from the University of Illinois. Prior to joining the UNC faculty, he was Director of Bands and Chairman of the Music Department at Willowbrook High School in Villa Park, IL, where his wind ensemble was twice named Illinois Concert Band Champion, and in 1984 was invited to perform at the MENC National Convention.

Dr. Bell frequently serves as a clinician, adjudicator, and guest conductor throughout the Mid-West and Canada, and he recently conducted clinics in Alabama and Kentucky. In 1987 he was appointed Music Director of the Rocky Mountain Brass Works, one of the oldest British Brass Bands west of the Mississippi.

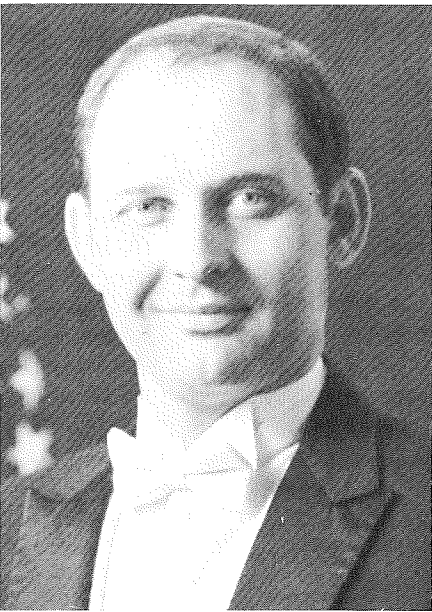
Lowell E. Graham

Major (Lt. Colonel Selectee) Lowell E. Graham is a native of Greeley, a graduate of the University of Northern Colorado, and has earned worldwide recognition as one of the most talented conductors in the U. S. Air Force music program.

After receiving his Bachelor of Music Education and Master of Arts degrees from UNC, he became Director of Instrumental Music at Colby Community College in Kansas. In 1975 Major Graham was appointed Conductor and Director of the U. S. Air Force String Orchestra and Strolling Strings. Two years later he received the first Doctor of Musical Arts in Orchestral Conducting degree awarded by the Catholic University of America. In 1984, after serving four years as Commander and Conductor of the Air Force Band of the Golden Gate, Travis Air Force Base, CA, he assumed his present command position with the Tactical Air Command Band, Langley Air Force Base, VA.

Under Major Graham's leadership, the TAC Band has become the most honored and decorated band in the Air Force, including recognition by the Commission on the Bicentennial of the U. S. Constitution, the "Order of the Long Leaf Pine" - North Carolina's highest award for artistic and cultural contributions, and the first "Colonel George S. Howard Citation of Musical Excellence."

Major Graham has issued several dozen highly acclaimed recordings, both with his Air Force ensembles and with the National Symphonic Winds. He is in constant demand as a clinician, and has conducted All-State ensembles in New York, Indiana and New Mexico. During both the past two summers Major Graham has been invited back to Greeley to conduct the UNC Summer Symphonic Band.

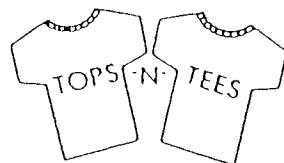

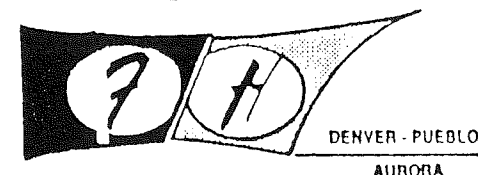
