Mitchell Fennell

Mitchell Fennell is Director of Bands at California State University, Fullerton. His responsibilities include conducting the University Wind Ensemble, Symphonic Band, and teaching conducting. He also assists with the music education program and coordinates all band activities.

Mr. Fennell has taught and conducted at the college and high school levels for the past fourteen years. He taught at Mission Viejo High School and California State University, Long Beach, before being appointed Director of Bands at Washburn University in Topeka, Kansas.

In addition to his teaching duties, Mr. Fennell is active outside the university community. His ensembles have performed at state and regional conventions, he regularly conducts high school honor bands, and he is a frequent lecturer on rehearsal techniques and music literature.

Mr. Fennell holds a Bachelor of Music in Performance from California State University, Long Beach, a Master of Music in Wind Conducting from the University of Northern Colorado, and this May will receive the Doctorate of Arts from the University of Northern Colorado.

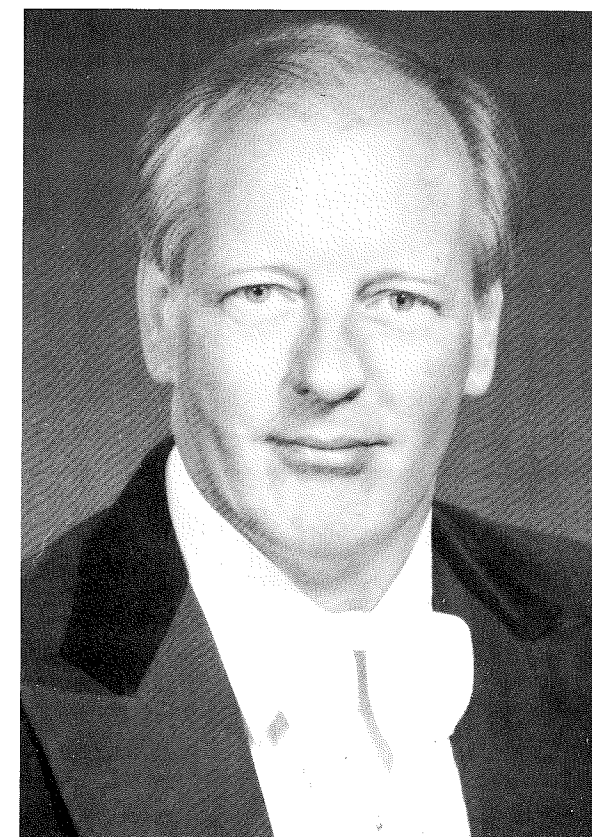
Thomas Lee

Thomas Lee is one of America's most active clinicians, having conducted high school, collegiate and professional wind groups throughout the United States and Canada.

He is Director of Bands and Professor of Music at the University of California, Los Angeles, where he conducts the Wind Ensemble, directs the graduate program in Wind Conducting, and is Chair of the Faculty of Performance/Music Education.

Prior to arriving at UCLA, Dr. Lee conducted the Wind Ensemble at the University of Texas, Austin, and was also Director of Bands at Ohio University in Athens. While in Ohio he commissioned a number of new works by American composers, resulting in a premiere performance at the Kennedy Center in Washington, D.C. He began his teaching career at Dowling High School in Des Moines, Iowa, where he also supervised the Des Moines Catholic Elementary Music program, and was a member of the Des Moines Symphony.

Dr. Lee earned bachelor's and master's degrees from Drake University, and received his doctorate from the Cincinnati College-Conservatory of Music. His teachers include Marcouiller, Elmer Thomas and Robert Hornyak.

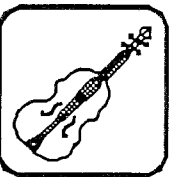
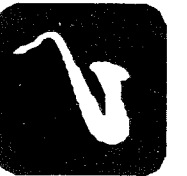
