Richard Lambrecht

Richard Lambrecht is Director of Bands at Coronado High School in El Paso, Texas. He has held that position since the fall of 1969. Through the years, Coronado's Symphonic Band and Marching Band have accumulated numerous awards and honors from various festivals across the country. Under the direction of Mr. Lambrecht, Coronado High School has placed 190 students in the Texas All-State groups with 170 of them qualifying since 1980. Many students continue to play in university ensembles. Approximately 40 of Mr. Lambrecht's students are now active music teachers.

In addition to his teaching duties, Mr. Lambrecht is active in the community. He has held the position of principal horn in the El Paso Symphony Orchestra for the last 25 years.

Mr. Lambrecht holds a Bachelor of Music Education Degree from the University of Texas at El Paso. He is past president of the Texas Bandmasters Association, current Regional chairman of TMEA, and the Musicians representative to the board of the El Paso Symphony. He is also a member of the American Federation of Musicians, and a lifetime member of PTA, NBA, IHS, and Phi Beta Mu.

Jerry Frederick Junkin

Jerry Junkin serves as Director of Wind Ensembles and Head of the Conducting Division at the University of Texas at Austin. As an Associate Professor of Conducting, Mr. Junkin teaches graduate courses in conducting and wind literature in addition to serving as Music Director and Conductor of the University of Texas Wind Ensemble, Chamber Winds and New Music Ensemble.

Professor Junkin holds degrees in music education and conducting from the University of Texas at Austin, and he has pursued additional coursework at the University of Michigan and the Oberlin Conservatory. Mr. Junkin served as Associate Director of Bands at UT Austin before assuming a similar position at the University of Michigan. From 1984-1988 he was Director of Bands and Conductor of the Wind Ensemble at the University of South Florida in Tampa. Ensembles under Professor Junkin's leadership have performed throughout the United States and Western Europe. In July, 1991 the University of Texas Wind Ensemble performed at the World Association of Symphonic Bands and Ensembles Conference in Manchester, England.

Active as a guest conductor and clinician, Mr. Junkin has appeared in some thirty-five states and eight European countries. He has won the praise of such notable composers as Warren Benson, Gunther Schuller, Karel Husa, Leslie Bassett and Jacob Druckman for his performances of their works.
