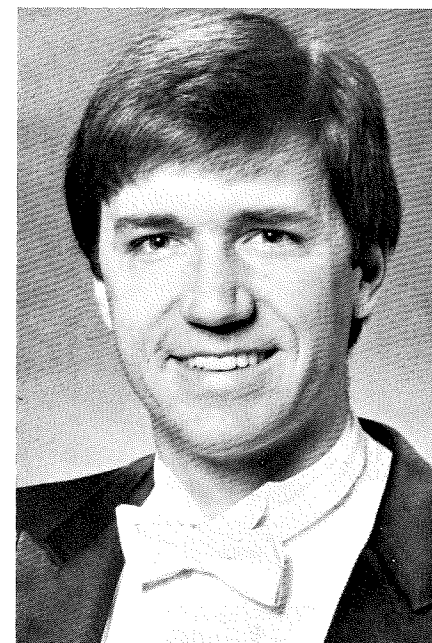

Stephen G. Peterson

Stephen G. Peterson is Assistant Director of Bands and Assistant Professor of Conducting at Northwestern University in Evanston, Illinois. He received Bachelor of Music and Master of Music degrees from Arizona State University, and a Doctor of Music degree from Northwestern University. In addition to his duties as conductor of both the Symphonic and Concert Bands, he is director of the "Wildcat" Marching Band, which was recently awarded the Sudler Trophy, the highest award given to a college marching band.

Dr. Peterson also teaches courses in conducting, marching band techniques, and music education. Previous to his appointment at Northwestern, he was Associate Director of Bands at Stephen F. Austin State University in Nacogdoches, Texas. Dr. Peterson has many years of experience as a successful teacher at the high school and university levels. He frequently serves as a clinician and adjudicator throughout the United States.

Richard E. Strange

Dr. Richard E. Strange, Professor of Music and Director of Bands at Arizona State University, received his degrees from Wichita State University, the University of Colorado, and Boston University, where he received the Doctor of Musical Arts in Performance. He has extensive professional experience as a performer on flute, oboe, clarinet and saxophone.

He has served as guest conductor of our major military bands, as well as the Dallas Wind Symphony and other American and European ensembles. Dr. Strange is active in the educational field as a clinician and guest conductor, and has conducted many Regional and All-State groups, as well as the University Wind Ensemble and Symphonic Band at the National Music Camp, Interlochen, Michigan. He has also conducted, judged or given clinics in Canada, Japan, The Netherlands, New Zealand, Guam, England and France. He is Music Director of the Tempe (Arizona) Symphony Orchestra.

In January of 1989, Dr. Strange received the Award for Excellence in Teaching Music from the Arizona Music Educators Association, and in 1991 he was awarded the Distinguished Service to Music medal by Kappa Kappa Psi, the National Honorary Band Fraternity. Also in 1991 he received the National Band Association's Citation of Excellence for his "outstanding contribution to bands and band music."

Dr. Strange writes for Bandworld magazine, and is Editor of the "Selective Music List for Bands" published by the National Band Association. He is a Past President of both the American Bandmasters Association and the College Band Directors National Association.
