All-State Band Clinicians

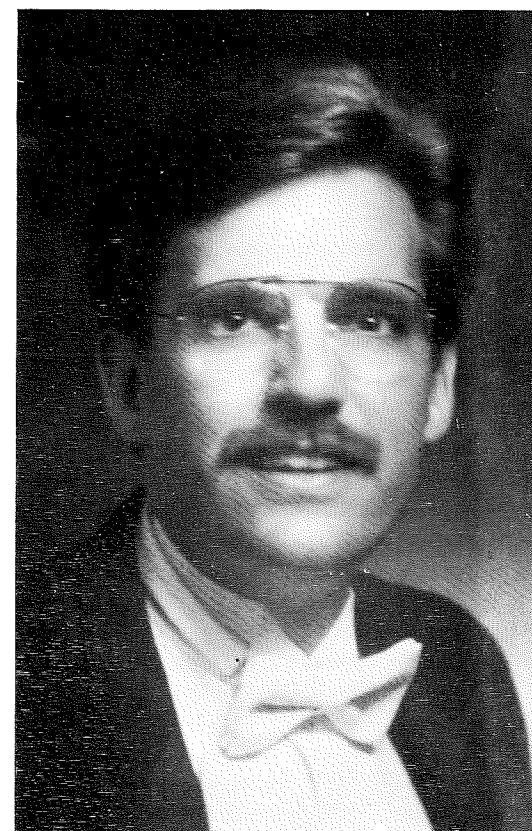
Gary Lewis

Gary Lewis is Assistant Professor of Music (Conducting) in The University of Michigan School of Music, and serves as Associate Director of Bands and Director of the Michigan Marching Band. Mr. Lewis received his Master of Music degree from Texas Tech University and his Bachelor of Music Education degree from the University of Oklahoma.

Prior to his appointment at The University of Michigan, Mr. Lewis served as Director of Bands at Abilene Christian University in Abilene, Texas. Under his direction, the Abilene Christian University performed before a conference of the College Band Directors National Association and served as the host ensemble for the annual ACU Conducting Symposium.

Mr. Lewis is very active as a conductor/clinician, having conducted bands and orchestras throughout the United States and Canada. He is also an active arranger whose works have been performed at conferences of the College Band Directors National Association, the National Band Association, Tubists Universal Brotherhood Association, and the Texas Music Educators Association. His arrangements have been played by the U.S. Army Band, Washington, DC, and the U.S. Air Force Band, Washington, D.C. (on their national tour and their most recent concerto album). His marching band arrangements have been performed nationwide by numerous public school and university bands.

In addition to leading the Michigan Marching Band, Mr. Lewis serves as co-conductor of the Symphony Band, Wind Ensemble and Contemporary Directions Ensemble, and assists with the orchestras. He also teaches courses in instrumental conducting and music education.

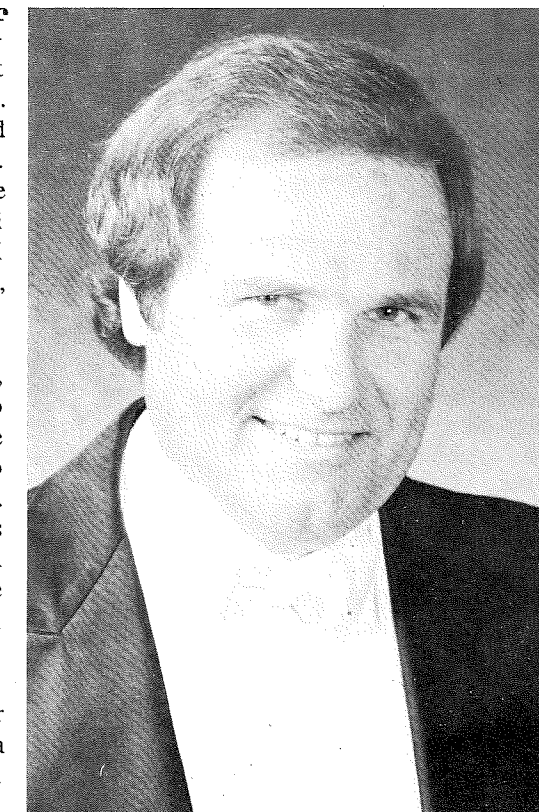


Craig Kirchoff

Craig Kirchoff is Professor of Conducting and Director of University Bands at the University of Minnesota, where he conducts the Symphonic Wind Ensemble. Professor Kirchoff coordinates the graduate program in Wind Ensemble/Band Conducting and guides all aspects of the University of Minnesota Band Program. Born and educated in Wisconsin, Mr. Kirchoff brings to his position a wide knowledge of both traditional and contemporary literature. He has won critical acclaim from composers Henry Brant, Michael Colgrass, Warren Benson, Karel Husa, George Perle, Vincent Persichetti, Verne Reynolds, Gunther Schuller, Joseph Schwantner, Elliott Schwartz and others.

Prior to his appointment to the faculty of the University of Minnesota, Professor Kirchoff served in a similar capacity as Director of Bands at The Ohio State University for fourteen years. Mr. Kirchoff was the recipient of the The Ohio State University Alumni Distinguished Teaching Award and The Ohio State University School of Music Distinguished Teaching Award. Mr. Kirchoff is President of the College Band Directors National Association and is a member of the American Bandmasters Association, the National Band Association, the World Association of Symphonic Bands and Ensembles, the Music Educators National Conference, and is the Founding Editor and Principal Advisor of the College Band Directors National Association Journal.

Professor Kirchoff has appeared as guest conductor, clinician, and lecturer throughout the United States, Canada, Europe, and Japan. Mr. Kirchoff is a frequent guest conductor of the Tokyo Kosei Wind Orchestra and has recorded with them on the Kosei Publishing Company label.
