All-State Band Clinicians

Richard Blatti



Richard Blatti currently serves The Ohio State University as Coordinator of University Bands and Associate Professor of Music. In addition to his duties as music director and conductor of the OSU Symphonic Band, he guides all aspects of the undergraduate and graduate wind conducting curricula and supervises the administration of the total university band program. Professor Blatti was the 1991 Recipient of The Ohio State University School of Music Distinguished Teaching Award.

Prior to his appointment at OSU, Professor Blatti was Associate Professor of Music at Albion College in Michigan. While there, he was selected as the outstanding "Faculty Member of the Year" on two different occasions and was awarded numerous grants in support of his research on rehearsal techniques and conducting pedagogy. Before moving to Michigan, Mr. Blatti held the position of Music Department Chairman and Director of Bands at York Community High School in Elmhurst, Illinois.

An avid proponent of the community band movement, Mr. Blatti co-founded the Albion Community Band in 1980 and has served in assisting other similar organizations in Michigan, Illinois, and Ohio. In addition, he has been invited to guest conduct and teach throughout the United States at numerous university campuses, school music programs, and summer camps.

Mr. Blatti earned both the Bachelor of Music Education and the Master of music degrees from Northwestern University, and is currently completing the Doctor of Musical Arts Degree in Conducting at Michigan State University. He is the current State President for the College Band Directors National Association.

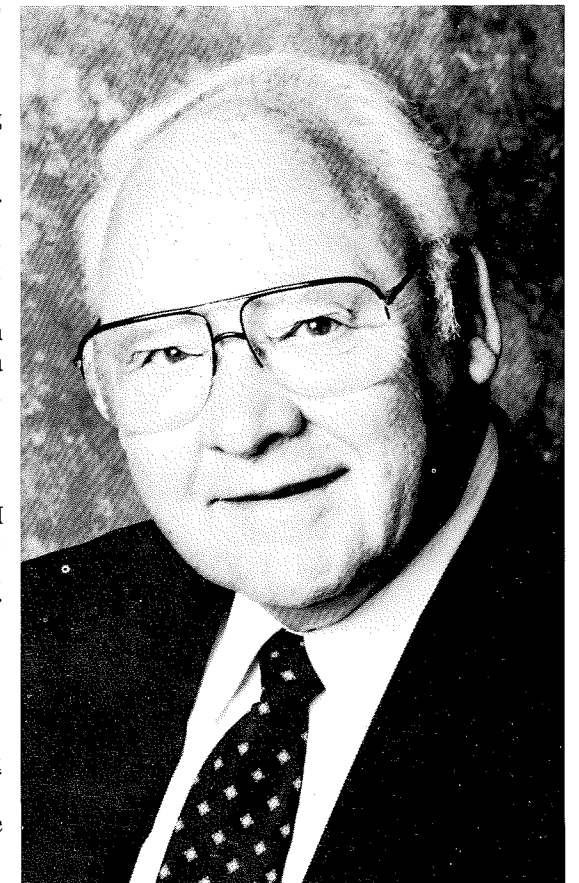
John P. Paynter

John Paynter has been Director of Bands at Northwestern University, Evanston, Illinois since 1953. In addition to heading the band program, he serves the School of Music as Professor of Conducting. He teaches courses in conducting and band arranging, and conducts many of the University musical productions.

One of the leading band conductors in America, Paynter has gained the respect of musicians everywhere, as evidenced by his high standing in the organizations he serves: World Association for Symphonic Bands and Ensembles (Past President), Mid-West International Band and Orchestra Clinic (President), American Bandmasters Association (Past President), National Band Association (co-founder, Past President), Music Educators National Conference and Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia (Life member). He was recently named Honorary Life President of the National Band Association.

Paynter was born in Mineral Point, Wisconsin where he received his early training in music. He entered Northwestern University in 1946 and earned BM and MM degrees in theory and composition in 1950 and 1951, serving as Acting Director of Bands in 1950-51 while working toward his Masters degree. At age 23, he was appointed to the full-time faculty (1951) and became Director of Marching Band, Assistant Director of Bands, and Instructor of Theory. Two years later, he succeeded Glenn Cliffe Bainum as Director of Bands, becoming the second person ever to hold this post at Northwestern University.

Paynter is the former editor of the "New Music" column of the *Instrumentalist* music magazine. He is also an active composer and arranger, with more than 400 works to his credit. As conductor since 1956 of the famous 115-piece Northshore Concert Band, he has been a world leader in the community band movement.
