**ALL-STATE BAND CLINICIANS**

*Tom Leslie*

As Director of Bands at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, Professor Leslie has earned national recognition for the quality performances of the UNLV Bands. During his tenure at UNLV, his bands have received critical acclaim from members of the international music world. Such notables include composer Malcolm Arnold; United States Marine Band Conductor Ret. Colonel John Bourgeois; United States Navy Band Conductor Commander John Pastin; Dr. Harry Begian, Director Emeritus, University of Illinois; GRP recording artist Eric Marienthal; and six-time Grammy nominee jazz pianist Stefan Karlsson.

Recognized for a fresh interpretative style among collegiate wind orchestras, Mr. Leslie and the UNLV Wind Orchestra continue to excel in their commitment to commission new works by the next generation of the world's finest young composers.

As an adjudicator and conductor in 34 states nationally, Professor Leslie has also been invited to conduct performances and clinics internationally in Japan, England, Scotland, France, Switzerland, Austria, Germany, and Canada. Under his direction, the UNLV Wind Orchestra has appeared as an invited performing group at the College Band Directors National Association (CBDNA) Conference and the Music Educators National Conference (MENC) Biennial Convention in Phoenix, Arizona.

Professor Leslie was inducted as a member of the prestigious American Bandmasters Association in 1997. In addition to presently serving as the Western Division Chair for the National Band Association, he continues to be a long-standing member of both the College Band Directors National Association and the Music Educators National Conference.



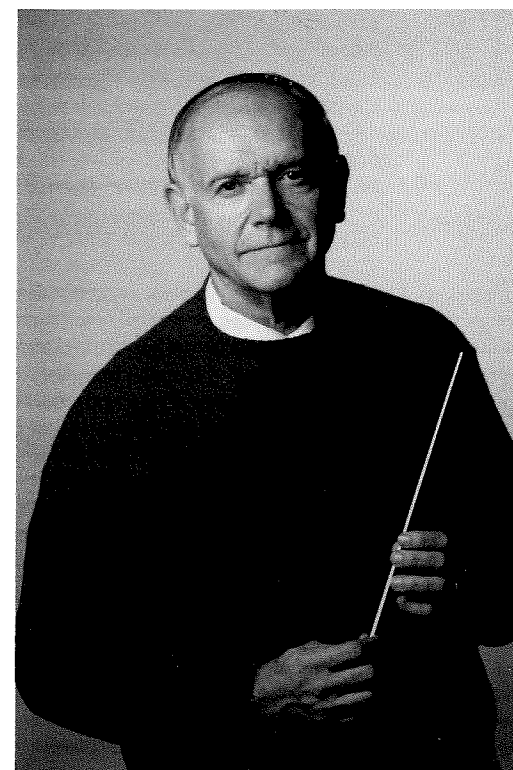
*Frank Battisti*

Frank L. Battisti is conductor of the New England Conservatory Wind Ensemble. Under Mr. Battisti's leadership the ensemble has established a national and international reputation for being one of the premier ensembles of its kind in the United States. It has performed often at music conferences throughout the United States, recorded for Centaur, Albany, and Golden Crest records and had many of its performances broadcast over the National Public Radio Network (NPR).

During the past 45 years Frank Battisti has been responsible for commissioning and premiering many works for wind ensemble by distinguished American and foreign composers. These composers include Robert Ceely, John Harbison, Robin Holloway, Witold Lutoslawski, William Thomas McKinley, Vincent Persichetti, Michael Colgrass, Daniel Pinkham, Robert Selig, Ivan Tcheripnin, Sir Michael Tippett, and Alec Wilder. Critics and colleagues have praised Battisti for his commitment to contemporary music and his outstanding performances.

Battisti has appeared often as a guest conductor with many university, college, military, professional, and high school bands and wind ensembles and as guest clinician and teacher in the United States, England, Europe, Middle East, Africa, Scandinavia, Australia, China, Taiwan, Canada, South America, South Korea, Iceland, and the former USSR.

He has held numerous national offices in various wind band/ensemble associations including President of the College Band Directors National Association (CBDNA). Battisti is a member of the American Bandmasters Association (ABA) and founder of the National Wind Ensemble Conference, World Association of Symphonic Bands and Ensembles (WASBE), Massachusetts Youth Wind Ensemble (MYWE), and New England College Band Association (NECBA). He has served on the Standard Award Panel of the American Society for Composers, Authors and Publishers (ASCAP) and been a member of the Music



Panel for the Arts Recognition and Talent Search (ARTS) for the National Foundation for the Advancement of the Arts. For many years Battisti served as editor for numerous music-publishing companies and is currently a consulting editor for *The Instrumentalist* magazine.

Mr. Battisti regularly contributes articles on wind ensemble/band literature, conducting, and music education to professional journals and magazines and is considered one of the foremost authorities in the world on wind music literature. He has received many awards and honors including an Honorary Doctor of Music degree from Ithaca College in 1992.
