ALL-STATE BAND CLINICIANS

Raydell Bradley

Raydell Bradley serves as Director of Concert Bands at Pacific Lutheran University, where he conducts both the University Wind Ensemble and Concert Band and teaches courses in music education, conducting and supervises student teachers. Under Professor Bradley's leadership, the University Wind Ensemble has established a national reputation for excellence in a small university setting.

Before accepting his post at PLU, Professor Bradley was Director of Bands at Fort Hays State University where his Symphonic Band was invited to perform for the Kansas Music Educators Workshop in 1989 (the only appearance in the past 20 years for this ensemble). Professor Bradley has also served as Assistant Director of Bands at Truman State University in Kirksville, Missouri and Director of Bands at Omaha North High School. Professor Bradley is the recipient of the Dorothy Danforth-Compton Doctoral Fellowship at the University of Washington, and is currently completing the Doctor of Musical Arts in Instrumental Conducting at the institution.

Professor Bradley has served as guest conductor and adjudicator in over 25 states and Canada. He also serves as Music Director of the Washington Wind Symphony, one of two professional wind bands in the Northwest region. Recent PLU Wind Ensemble honors under Professor Bradley's direction include performances for the 1994 and 1998 College Band Directors National Association Convention in Reno, Nevada; the 1996 Washington Music Educators Convention; and the 1998 Hawaii Music Educators Convention in Honolulu. The ensemble has also been featured on National Public Radio. Professor Bradley has been nominated as Vice-President of the Northwest Region of the College Band Directors National Association and as the Band Representative to the Washington Music Educators Association. He is the coordinator of the Northwest High School Honor Band Festival, and founder of the Northwest High School Band Camp and the Northwest Wind Conductors Symposium, all held at PLU.



Timothy Mahr



Timothy Mahr is an associate professor music at St. Olaf College in Northfield, Minnesota, where he is the Conductor of the St. Olaf Band. In addition, he teaches courses in composition, conducting and music education, and supervises instrumental student teaching. Previous to his appointment in 1994 at St. Olaf, Mahr was Director of Bands at the University of Minnesota, Duluth, for ten years and taught instrumental music at Milaca High School (MN) for three years. Mahr is the principal conductor of the Twin Cities-based Minnesota Symphonic Winds and, while in Duluth, was the founder and conductor of the Twin Ports Wind Ensemble. He is presently the President of the North Central Division of the College Band Directors National Association (1999-2001) and has served as an At-Large Representative on the Board of Directors of the National Band Association and was a founding board member of the Minnesota Band Directors Association.

Active as a guest conductor and clinician, Mahr is in demand across the nation and in Norway and Canada as a conductor of all-state bands, intercollegiate bands and honor band festivals. He has been in residence as a guest composer/conductor on over twenty-five college and university campuses and has twice conducted performances with the Duluth-Superior Symphony Orchestra. This year he will conduct All-State Bands in Montana, Massachusetts, California and Colorado, as well as the top bands at the Interlochen Arts Camp and the Bands of America Summer Institute. Under Mahr's baton, the St. Olaf Band traveled to Norway in the summer of 1996 and will tour the British Isles this coming summer. Additionally, the St. Olaf Band performed at the 1997 American Bandmasters Association Convention in San Diego during its California tour and presented an invited performance at the 1998 Minnesota Music Educators Association Mid-Winter Clinic. Since 1994, the St. Olaf Band has produced six compact disc recordings, two of which have received international acclaim.

Mahr was the first recipient of a commission from the American Bandmasters Association Commissioning Project, and the resultant work, *Endurance*, was premiered by the United States Interservice Band in Washington, DC. He has also received commissions from the US Air Force Band, the Music Educators National Conference, and Kappa Kappa Psi/Tau Beta Sigma (National Honorary Band Fraternities) among others. Dr. Mahr holds two undergraduate degrees from St. Olaf in Theory/Composition and Music Education. He also holds a Master of Arts degree in Trombone Performance and a Doctor of Musical Arts degree in Instrumental Conducting, both from the University of Iowa.
