## ALL-STATE BAND CLINICIANS

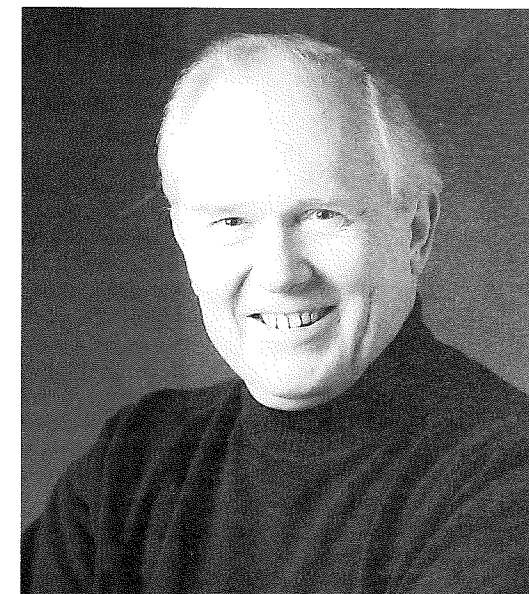
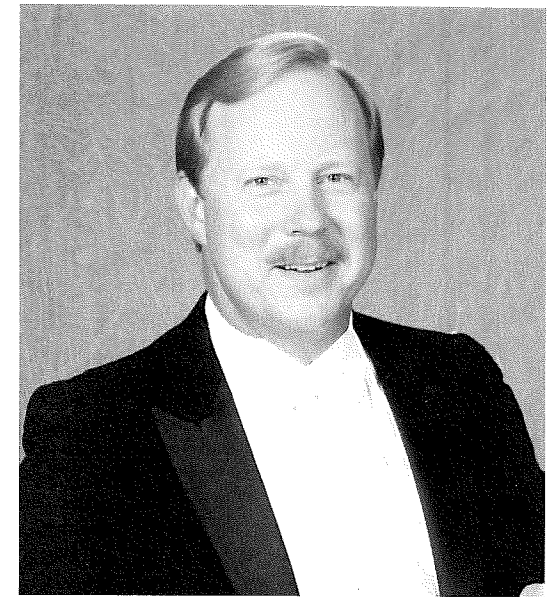
*Bruce Ammann*

is in his twelfth year as Director of Bands and Professor of Music at Augustana College in Sioux Falls, South Dakota. From 1993 through 1998, Dr. Ammann served as the Chairman of the Music Department. Previous to his appointment at Augustana, Dr. Ammann was on the faculty of Arizona State University where he spent two years completing the Doctor of Musical Arts Degree in Instrumental Conducting. From 1984 to 1987, Dr. Ammann was Assistant Director of Bands and Professor of Saxophone at the University of Florida. He holds the Bachelor of Music Degree in Music Education and the Master of Music Degree in Saxophone Performance from the University of Arizona. Prior to his appointment at the University of Florida, Dr. Ammann taught all levels of public school instrumental music. His last five years of public school teaching were as Director of Bands at Sahuaro High School in Tucson, Arizona. While at Sahuaro High School his bands consistently earned superior ratings in concert, marching, and jazz festivals throughout the southwest.

Dr. Ammann served as Director of the Sioux Falls Municipal Band for four years, completing his tenure during the summer of 1995. He conducted the band in over 35 concerts each summer at various parks in the Sioux Falls area.

Dr. Ammann is active as an adjudicator and clinician throughout the country. His professional memberships include the College Band Directors National Association (CBDNA), Music Educators National Conference (MENC), South Dakota Bandmasters Association (SDBA), National Band Association (NBA), Association of Concert Bands (ACB), Kappa Kappa Psi, Tau Beta Sigma, Phi Mu Alpha, and Phi Beta Mu. In March of 1996 Dr. Ammann was elected into membership of the American Bandmasters Association (ABA), and in March of 1997 he received the Phi Beta Mu Outstanding Bandmaster Award for the state of South Dakota.

Dr. Ammann has served on the governing board for the South Dakota Music Educators Association (SDMEA) since 1992. In July of 1998, he became President of SDMEA. In the fall of 1994 he was elected to the board of directors for the Association of Concert Bands (ACB) and served until 1996. He is also the South Dakota State Chairman for CBDNA and NBA.



*H. Robert Reynolds*

is the Henry F. Thurnau Professor of Music, Director of University Bands and Director of the Division of Instrumental Studies at the School of Music of the University of Michigan. In addition to his responsibilities at the University of Michigan he has also been, for nearly 20 years, the conductor of a professional ensemble, The Detroit Chamber Winds and Strings, which is made up primarily of members of the Detroit Symphony.

Robert Reynolds has conducted recordings for Koch International, Pro Arte, Caprice, and Deutsche Grammophon. In the United States, he has conducted at Carnegie Hall and Lincoln Center (New York), Orchestra Hall (Chicago), Kennedy Center (Washington, D.C.), Powell Symphony Hall (St. Louis), and the Academy of Music (Philadelphia). In Europe, he conducted the premiere of an opera for La Scala Opera (Milan, Italy), and the concerts at the Maggio Musicale (Florence, Italy), the Tonhalle (Zurich, Switzerland), the Concertgebouw (Amsterdam, Holland) as part of the Holland Festival, and at the 750<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the City of Berlin. He has conducted numerous premiere performances and has won the praise of composers: Aaron Copland, Darius Milhaud, Gyorgy Ligeti, Henryk Gorecki, Gunther Schuller, Leslie Bassett, William Bolcom, Bernard Rands, Karel Husa, Karlheinz Stockhausen, and many others for his interpretive conducting of their compositions.

Mr. Reynolds holds degrees in Music Education and Performance from the University of Michigan where he was the conducting student of Elizabeth Green. He began his career in the Onsted Michigan Public Schools, then moved to Anaheim (California) High School before beginning his university conducting at California State University at Long Beach. He subsequently moved to the University of Wisconsin before coming to the University of Michigan in 1975.

Professor Reynolds is Past President of the College Band Directors' National Association and the Big Ten Band Directors' Association. He is listed in "Who's Who in America" and "Who's Who in the World" and has received the highest national awards from Phi Mu Alpha, Kappa Kappa Psi, the National Band Association, and the American School Band Directors' Association. Currently he serves as one of five members of the National Awards Panel for the American Society of Composers, Authors and Publishers (ASCAP), and his frequent conducting appearances have included the Eastman School of Music, New England Conservatory, University of Southern California, Oberlin Conservatory, Northwestern University, UCLA, the National Arts Camp at Interlochen, and the National Wind Ensemble each year at Carnegie Hall.

Robert Reynolds has been a featured conductor and lecturer at international conferences in Norway, Belgium, England, and Holland. He has conducted in many of the major cities of Japan and his numerous visits to Sweden include concerts with the Stockholm Wind Orchestra, Linkoping Wind Orchestra, and the Norrkoping Symphony Orchestra. He has served as master teacher for the Sverges Orkesterforeningars Riksforbund in Stockholm, Gothenberg, Udevalla, Orebro, and Linkoping, Sweden. In addition to being the master conductor/teacher for the Europaisches Seminar fur Dirigenten von Blasorchestern at the Bundesakademie in Trossingen (Germany), the Austrian Wind Band Conductors Association, and the wind conductors of Slovenia, he is the only American to have conducted the famed Kongelige Musikkorps Koncertfond (Royal Danish Band) of Copenhagen, Denmark. Professor Reynolds is committed to teaching and attracts the finest students from the United States and abroad, and many of these students now hold major conducting positions at leading universities.
