

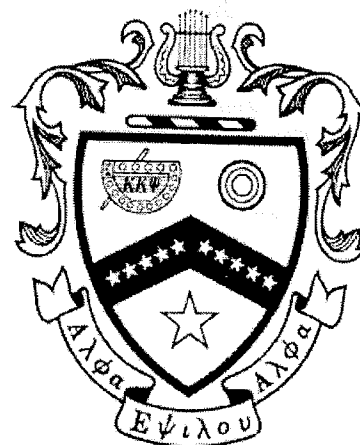

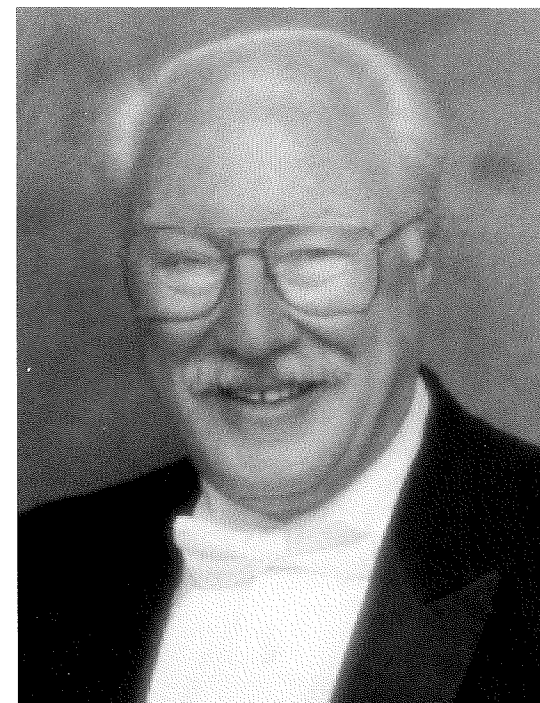

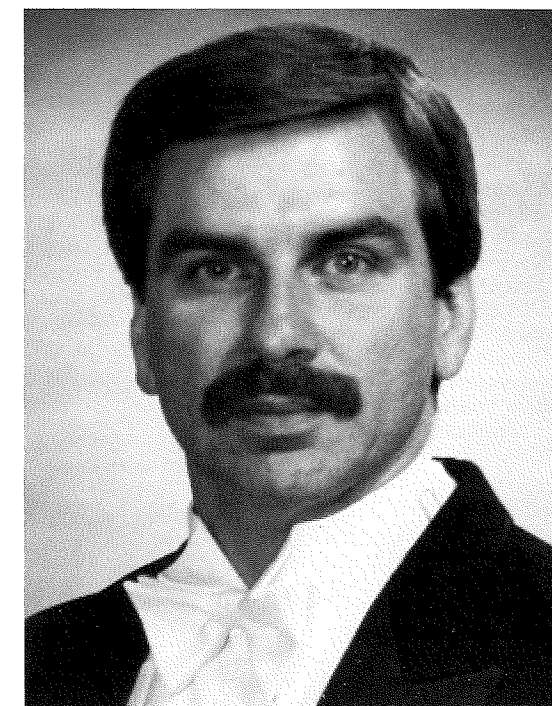

Kenneth Bloomquist

Kenneth G. Bloomquist is the Michigan State University Director of Bands Emeritus. Professor Bloomquist joined the MSU faculty in 1970 as Director of Bands, coming from the University of Kansas where he held that same position. He was Director of the School of Music at MSU from 1978 to 1988. Degrees were earned at the University of Illinois and his experience includes teaching in the public schools and military service in the United States Army. Significant among his many publications are "The Anatomy of a Rehearsal," in five parts, published by the Instrumentalist, 1981; "School Band Movement Phase II," Gemeinhardt, 1982, and "Pedal Tone Study for Trumpet," published by the Getzen Company. Conducting, Rehearsal and Adjudication Seminars have been given at National Conferences and Universities throughout the United States and at several locations in Southeast Asia. Professor Bloomquist is a Past President of the American Bandmasters Association and a Past President of the National Band Association. Several Honors have been bestowed upon Professor Bloomquist, including the American School Band Directors Association Harding Award, the Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia Orpheus Award, the National Band Association Citation of Excellence, induction into the National Band Association's Academy of Wind and Percussion Arts and, most recently, into the NBA Hall of Fame. Professor Bloomquist has appeared as guest conductor, clinician and adjudicator throughout the United States, Europe, Scandinavia, Southeast Asia, Japan, Australia and Mexico. Most recently, in the summer of 2000 and 2001, he appeared as guest conductor at the Czech Music Camp for Youth in the Czech Republic. In the fall of 1998, 2000 and 2002 he was Conductor-in-Residence at the Musashino Academia Musicae in Tokyo, Japan. He maintains an extremely active schedule as a guest conductor, clinician and adjudicator throughout the world.

Dr. A. G. "Mack" McGrannahan III has served on the music faculty of the University of Nevada since 1975, and assumed the position of Director of Bands in 1979. In 1980 he was given the responsibility of reorganizing the Wolf Pack Marching Band, which had not been in existence since 1969. A native of Lexington, Kentucky, Dr. McGrannahan received the Bachelor of Music Education degree from Murray State University, and the Master of Music and Doctor of Musical Arts degrees in trombone performance and conducting from the University of North Texas. As Director of Bands his responsibilities include conducting the Wind Ensemble and administering the entire band program. At the University, Dr. McGrannahan instructs trombone, euphonium and tuba students as well as teaching courses in conducting and secondary instrumental methods. The University of Nevada Wind Ensemble, under Dr. McGrannahan's direction, has appeared on numerous occasions at music conferences and conventions throughout the western states, and is a frequent attraction at the Nevada Music Educators state convention. Dr. McGrannahan has been the director of the Lake Tahoe Music Camp, one of the most popular summer music camps on the west coast for the past twenty-four years. He has played professionally in several show bands in the Reno/Lake Tahoe area, performing with Sammy Davis, Jr., Tony Bennett, Natalie Cole, Ben Vereen, Neil Sedaka, Henry Mancini, Jack Jones, Gladys Knight and the Pips, Debbie Reynolds, and others. He is currently the Principal Trombonist in the Reno Philharmonic Orchestra, and performs with the Great Basin Brass Quintet. Active as an adjudicator and guest conductor throughout Nevada as well as other states, Dr. McGrannahan is a Past President of the Nevada Music Educators Association and the Western Division of the College Band Directors National Association. In addition, he holds membership in Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia, Pi Kappa Lambda, National Band Association, Music Educators National Conference, and the International Trombone Association.
