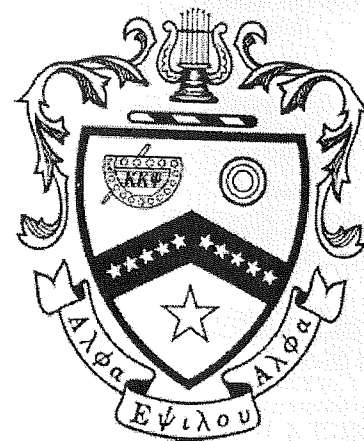

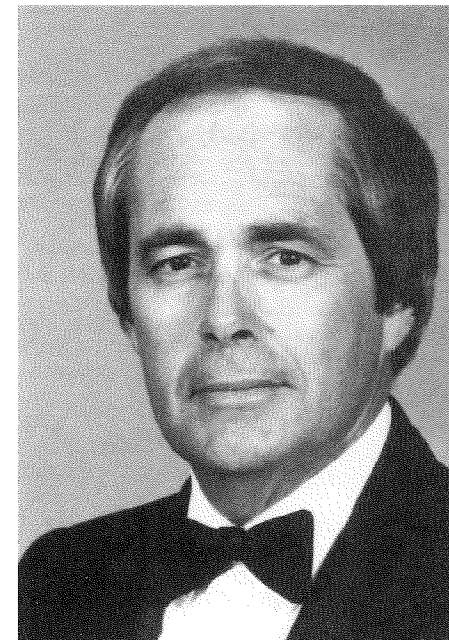

Richard Floyd

Richard Floyd is presently in his 40th year of active involvement as a conductor, music educator and administrator. He has enjoyed a distinguished and highly successful career at virtually every level of wind band performance, from beginning band programs through high school and university wind ensembles as well as adult community bands. Presently, Floyd serves as State Director of Music at the University of Texas at Austin where he coordinates all facets of secondary school music competition for some 3500 performing organizations throughout the state. He also holds the post of Musical Director and Conductor of the Austin Symphonic Band, which is viewed as one of the premier adult concert bands in America.

Prior to his appointment at the University of Texas, Mr. Floyd served on the faculties at the University of South Florida as Professor of Conducting, and at Baylor University in Texas where he held the position of Director of Bands for nine years. His musical achievements include appearances at numerous state and regional music conferences, a distinguished performance for the 1977 College Band Directors National Association, the 1981 Music Educators National Conference, the 1989 Grand Finale concert for the Mid-West International Band and Orchestra Clinic in Chicago, and the opening concert for the 1993 American Bandmasters Association Convention in New Orleans. Recently the Austin Symphonic Band returned to the Mid-West International Band and Orchestra Clinic to again present the Grand Finale Concert in 1997. Before joining the faculty at Baylor he taught junior high school and high school band in the Richardson, Texas public schools and served as music coordinator for that district's nationally acclaimed music program.

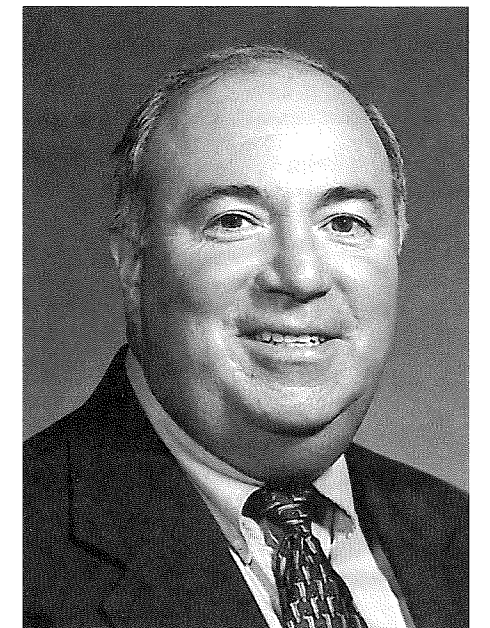
Mr. Floyd is a recognized authority on conducting, the art of wind band rehearsing, concert band repertoire, and music advocacy. As such, he has toured extensively throughout the United States, Canada, Australia and Europe as a clinician, adjudicator and conductor including appearances in 40 American states and in 9 other countries. In 2002 he was the single recipient of the prestigious A.A. Harding Award presented by the American School Band Directors Association in recognition of his significant and lasting contributions to the school band movement.

Dr. James R. Saker is Professor of Music and Director of Bands at the University of Nebraska at Omaha, a position he has held since 1978. He also served as Chair of the Department of Music from 1992 through 1999 and resumed that leadership role in 2001. Under his leadership the University Marching and Concert Bands have received regional and national acclaim. The Symphonic Wind Ensemble (SWE) has performed for numerous state, regional, national, and international conferences including the International Conference of the Association of Concert Bands and the regional conference of The College Band Directors National Association (CBDNA). With a third European Concert Tour completed in the spring of 2002, the SWE is now planning for a spring 2004 Tour to the Sister Cities and Universities in Ireland, Wales, and England and a special performance at the 60th Anniversary Commemoration of the D-Day landings in Normandy, France.

Dr. Saker has received the University's Great Teacher Award, a Nebraska Board of Regents Commendation, and has twice been the recipient of the National Band Association Citation of Excellence. In 1993, he was recognized by the Nebraska State Bandmasters Association as the recipient of the prestigious Donald A. Lentz Outstanding Bandmaster Award. In the Spring of 1997, Dr. Saker was named to an endowed chair as the Isaacson Distinguished Professor of Music and in 1999 he was presented with the "Chancellor's Medal," the highest honor awarded by the University. In 2003 he was chosen for the "Andersen-Gouttierre Award" that was presented by the University's Division of International Studies and Programs "in recognition of his contributions to enhance the international awareness of the citizens of Nebraska."

He has served the profession as President of the Nebraska State Bandmasters Association and as President of the Nebraska Music Educators Association. Currently he is State Chair for CBDNA.

An active clinician and lecturer, he has presented sessions at numerous state, regional and national Music Educators Association Conferences and at the regional and national conventions of the College Band Directors National Association. Also, he has guest conducted high school, collegiate, honors and professional groups throughout the United States, and in Canada and Europe.
