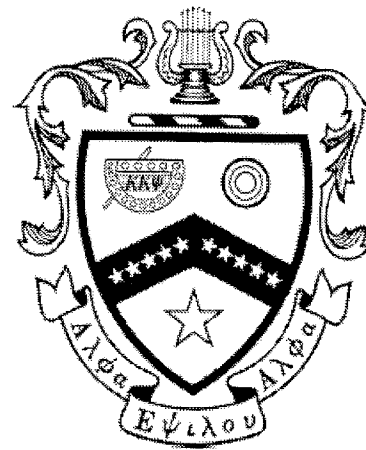

Appointed to the LSU music faculty in 1985, she conducts the LSU Symphonic Winds, and is Co-Director of the LSU Tiger Marching Band, where she oversees the administrative activities and serves as show coordinator, drill designer, and music and field instructor. In addition, Moorhouse administers the LSU summer music camps, teaches courses in undergraduate instrumental conducting, and is the faculty advisor and a *Member Laureate* of Sigma Alpha Iota, international fraternity for women in music.

She is a past recipient of the LSU School of Music's *Excellence in Teaching Award*, the Women Band Directors International *Scroll of Excellence, Silver Baton*, and most recently, *International Golden Rose*. She was honored in 2003 by the Epsilon Chapter of Phi Beta Mu as the *Outstanding Bandmaster* for Louisiana.

Outside LSU, Moorhouse maintains an active schedule having appeared as a guest conductor, clinician and adjudicator throughout the United States, Western Europe and Western Canada. She currently serves as President of the National Band Association, is the Louisiana Chair of the College Band Directors National Association, and is an elected member of the American Bandmasters Association and Phi Beta Mu. A Past-President of the Women Band Directors International, she is also a member of the John Philip Sousa Foundation Sudler Committee.

She has contributed as a Research Associate for three volumes of the *Teaching Music Through Performance in Band* series (GIA Publications), and is a contributing author for *A Composer's Insight: Thoughts, Analysis, and Commentary on Contemporary Masterpieces for Wind Band, Volume 2* (Meredith Music Publications).

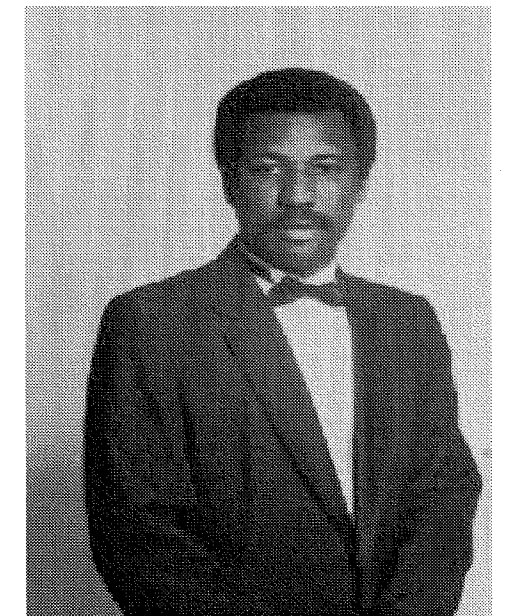
Moorhouse received a Bachelor of Music Education degree from the University of Florida, and a Master of Music Education degree from LSU. She is currently a degree candidate for a Doctor of Musical Arts in Wind Conducting at the University of Washington in Seattle.

Alfred Watkins has been Director of Bands at Lassiter High School since 1982. He has established a fine reputation as an adjudicator, clinician, and guest conductor throughout the United States. Under his leadership, the Lassiter Band has grown from its original seventy-eight members to its present size of over three hundred music students. The band program now includes five symphonic bands, marching band, two jazz bands, four concert percussion ensembles, numerous chamber ensembles and three indoor winter guards.

Mr. Watkins pioneered the concept of the Symphonic Band Camp, a three-day post-marching season intensive study of symphonic literature. The camp concept is currently implemented by hundreds of school band programs throughout the country. Lassiter's top two symphonic bands performed at the Bands of America National Concert Band Festival. In 1989, and again in 1996, the Lassiter Symphonic Band performed at the Mid-West International Band and Orchestra Clinic. In 1989, the band earned the Sudler Flag of Honor, presented by the John Philip Sousa Foundation for outstanding concert bands.

The Marching Trojan Band is a Two-Time Bands of America (BOA) Grand National Champion. The marching band has participated in the 1999 and 2004 Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade and the 1988, 2001 and 2005 Pasadena Tournament of Roses Parade. In 1999, the Trojan Band earned the Sousa Foundation Sudler Shield, for excellence in marching band activities.

Mr. Watkins is a member of Kappa Kappa Psi Honorary Band Fraternity, National Band Association, Phi Beta Mu National School Bandmaster Fraternity, Black Music Caucus, Music Educators National Conference and the Georgia Music Educators Association and the NAACP. He is on the band selection committee of the John Philip Sousa Foundation. In 2005 Mr. Watkins was elected into the prestigious American Bandmasters Association. Mr. Watkins has served on the Educational Advisory Board of Bands of America and currently serves as an adjudicator for Bands of America (BOA). In 1996, Mr. Watkins was Associate Director for the Atlanta Olympic Marching Band that performed in the Opening and Closing Ceremonies of the 1996 Centennial Olympic Games in Atlanta. He and his wife Rita live in Marietta with their two sons, Christopher and Jonathan.
