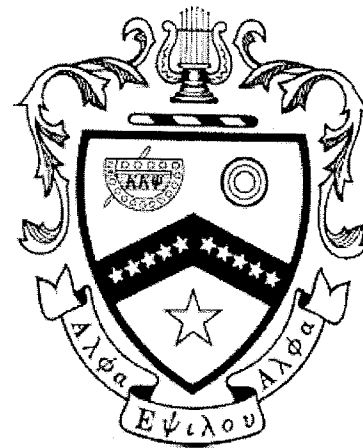

Richard Blatti

Richard Blatti currently serves The Ohio State University as Head of the Ensembles and Conducting Area and as Associate Director of Bands. In addition to his duties as music director and conductor of the OSU Symphonic Band, he supervises all aspects of the undergraduate conducting curricula for the School of Music and assists in the coordination of the graduate conducting program and the administration of university ensembles and events. Ensembles under his direction have recorded for the Delos International, Boosey & Hawkes, and Mark Recording labels, and have performed at national and regional levels for the College Band Directors National Association, the American Bandmasters Association, and the Ohio Music Educators Association. Professor Blatti is the only person to have twice received The Ohio State University School of Music Distinguished Teaching Award, in 1991 and in 2001.

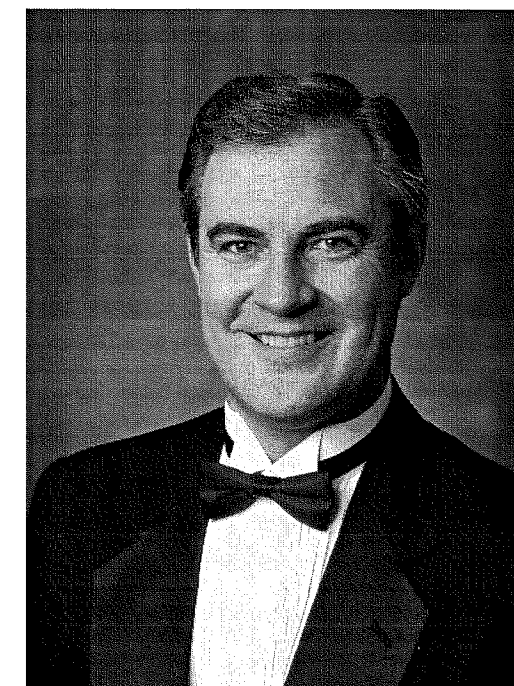
As guest conductor, clinician and adjudicator, Blatti has been invited to 36 states, 5 provinces in Canada, and the United Kingdom, The Netherlands, France, Belgium, Australia, and China. Prior to his appointment at OSU, Professor Blatti was Director of Instrumental Music at Albion College in Michigan. During his tenure there he was twice selected the outstanding Faculty Member of the Year, and was awarded two grants in support of his research on rehearsal techniques and conducting pedagogy.

Blatti earned both the Bachelor of Music Education and the Master of Music degrees from Northwestern University and has done post-graduate work in conducting at Michigan State University. He is a member of ABA, CBDNA, MENC, Pi Kappa Lambda, Phi Beta Mu, Omicron Delta Kappa, Tau Beta Sigma and Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia. He also serves as a Director of the John P. Paynter Foundation. He is in constant demand as a guest conductor, clinician, adjudicator, and lecturer.

Dr. Donald Peterson received both his B.M. and M.M. degrees in music education from Brigham Young University, followed by the D.M.A. degree in instrumental music/conducting from Arizona State University. During his nine years as director at American Fork High School, the concert, marching, and jazz bands were recipients of more than 100 awards and recognitions. He was also recognized with the Utah Music Educators Association "Superior Accomplishment Award" in 1982, and awarded both the Utah state and southwest regional Stanbury Awards in recognition of outstanding young band directors by the American School Band Directors Association.

Don is currently in his twentieth year at B.Y.U., where he serves as associate professor in music education and director of both the Marching and Symphonic Bands. In 1997 he organized the first Utah Ambassadors of Music—an honor band and choir which completed their fifth performance tour of Europe this past July. His publications include articles in both *Bandworld* magazine and *Band Director's Guide* and he has been involved in research of Russian band music. His groups have premiered Russian band works and his edition of "Zaparovshki March" has been performed in much of the U.S. as well as Europe.

In 2005, he published an interactive DVD for the study of "Instrumental Rehearsal Techniques"—designed to aid in the development of both prospective music educators and younger professionals. An interesting mesh of profession and hobby—which began when he built batons for his graduating students—has grown into a custom baton service ("Don's Batons") with designs that are used by a number of conductors from across the country. Mr. Peterson also maintains a very active schedule as adjudicator, clinician and guest conductor throughout the United States, while continuing to mentor many of his graduates teaching in the Utah public schools. He and his wife Diane reside in Provo, Utah and are the parents of six children.
