Songwriter Kasia Livingston's music has been recorded by Gloria Gaynor, Jessica Simpson, Eden's Crush, Cynthia Clausen, and Plus One, among others. Her hit, *StickWithU*, recorded by the Pussycat Dolls was number one in the United States in 2006 and since has received huge airplay internationally. But, in addition to her prolific work as a composer of popular music, Kasia has also created a catalogue of more introspective songs which reveal the quiet and tender resonance of her soul. *My Mother's Faith* was written in 1997 as her homage to the unique and priceless place that mothers hold in this world. A song about caretaking, about the way in which deep and unconditional love can guide and protect, it speaks to every family which is blessed to know the touch of a mother's devotion. In the summer of 2006, I asked my good friend, Shelly Berg, if he would be interested in setting the song for symphonic band. More an instrumental cradle than an arrangement, Shelly's treatment preserves the ethos of the original song while lighting new pathways to its essence. An utterance, which could only come from the human heart, a *Portrait of My Mother's Faith* is as much a window into Shelly as it is into Kasia.

◆ ALL-STATE BAND CLINICIANS ◆

*Mark Fonder*, Professor of Music, is the conductor of the Ithaca College Concert Band and has been teaching conducting and instrumental music education courses at Ithaca College since 1989. From 1994 to 2003, he was the Chairman of the Music Education Department. He is active as a guest conductor, adjudicator, school music consultant, and clinician and has served in these capacities throughout the United States. Internationally, he has guest conducted, given research presentations or adjudicated bands in Austria, Japan, Canada, China, Singapore, Sweden and the United Kingdom. Dr. Fonder, a graduate of and twice a fellowship recipient at the University of Illinois, was director of bands at Park Falls (Wisconsin) High School and was on the faculties of the University of Wisconsin-Green Bay and University of Texas-San Antonio prior to coming to New York. He has also served on the faculties of The University of Washington, VanderCook College and the Eastman School of Music. Dr. Fonder's research has been published in various journals including the *Music Educators Journal*, *Band Directors Guide*, *Instrumentalist*, *Journal of Band Research*, *Council for Research in Music Education* and the *Journal of Research in Music Education*. He was chair of the *Music Educators Journal* Editorial Committee from 1998-2002 and is currently the editor of the *Journal of Historical Research in Music Education*. Dr. Fonder has played principal trombone with the Green Bay (Wisconsin) Symphony, with the San Antonio Brass, and for such entertainers as Robert Goulet, Rich Little, and Rita Moreno. In 1987, Dr. Fonder was awarded the National Band Association-Wisconsin Chapter Citation of Excellence, in 1998, the Ithaca College President's Recognition Award and has been the recipient of a University of Wisconsin teaching fellowship. He has been elected to Phi Delta Kappa, an honorary education fraternity, Phi Kappa Phi, an honorary scholars fraternity, and Pi Kappa Lambda, an honorary music fraternity. He was selected to *Who's Who Among America's Teachers* in 2005-2006 and *Who's Who in America* in 2008.



*Larry Livingston* is a distinguished conductor, educator, administrator, and a highly respected motivational speaker. The founding Music Director of the Illinois Chamber Orchestra, Livingston has appeared with the Houston Symphony and in the Los Angeles Philharmonic Green Umbrella Series. He has conducted at the Festival de Musique in Evian, France, and has led the Stockholm Wind Orchestra, as well as the Leopoldinum Chamber, Chopin Academy, and Wroclaw Academy Orchestras in Poland. He served as Music Director of the Pan Pacific Festival Orchestras in Sydney, participated as a performer and clinician at the International Jazz Festival in Rome, and conducted an electro-acoustic ensemble in concerts in Tokyo under the auspices of Yamaha International. Mr. Livingston has led the American Youth Symphony Orchestra, the Young Musicians Foundation Orchestra, the USC Thornton Chamber and Symphony Orchestras in Los Angeles and the USC Thornton Contemporary Music Ensemble in Berlin. In 2001, he served on the jury for the renowned Besancon International Conducting Competition in Besancon, France.

Holding Baccalaureate and Master's degrees from the University of Michigan, Mr. Livingston completed Ph.D. coursework in theoretical studies at the University of California, San Diego. He studied conducting and interpretation with Laurence Livingston, Elizabeth Green, William Revelli, Keith Humble, Rafael Druian, and Herbert Zipper. In 1988 he received the Alumnus of the Year Award from the University of Michigan School of Music. From 1977 to 1982, Mr. Livingston served as Vice President and Music Director of the New England Conservatory of Music in Boston, where he was also Conductor of the Symphony Orchestra and Contemporary Music Ensemble. Subsequently, he became Dean of the Shepherd School of Music and Elma Schneider Professor of Music (Conducting) at Rice University in Houston. From 1986 until 2002, Mr. Livingston served as Dean of the USC Flora L. Thornton School of Music, where he is Chair of the Conducting Department, and Music Director of Thornton School Orchestras. In 2004, he was the first music administrator accepted into the Harvard University Executive Education Program. In 2007, Mr. Livingston received the Life in the Arts Award from Idyllwild Arts and an Outstanding Teacher Award from the student chapter of the USC Center for Religion. As a motivational speaker, he has established a national reputation for inspiring presentations to corporate and business leaders across the United States. From 2002, to 2007 he was a member of the Board of Directors of the Guitar Center, the world's largest retail music store chain.

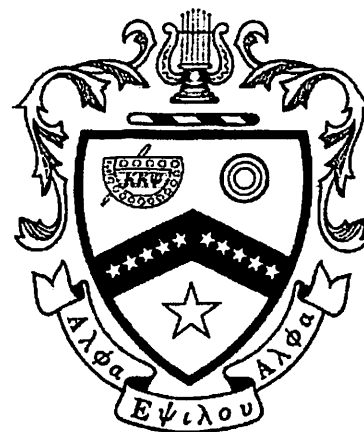
