

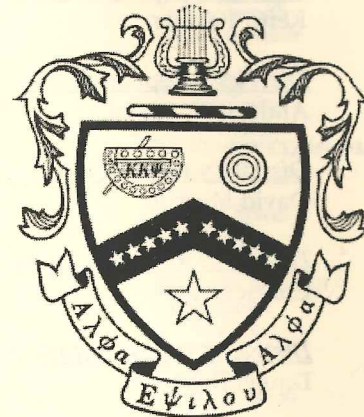

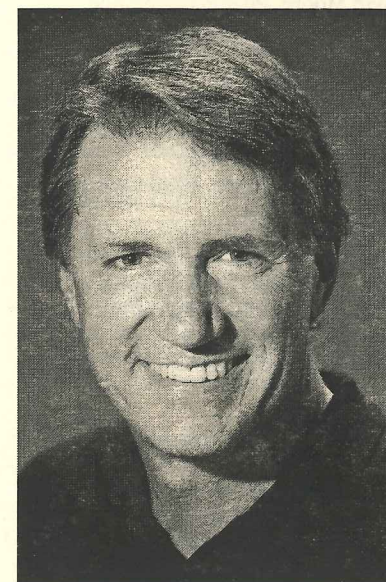
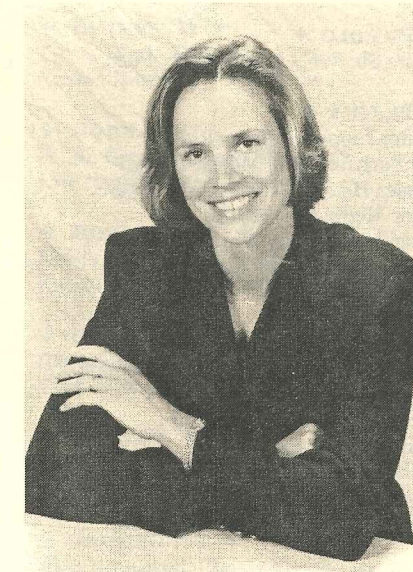

Dr. Elizabeth Jackson Kirchhoff completed her Bachelor of Arts in Music Education at St. Olaf College in 1983. She went on to earn a Master of Music in Wind Conducting at Northwestern University and a Ph.D. in Music Education at The Ohio State University. She is active as an instrumental music educator, conductor, and clinician throughout the United States and in Norway. Her recent professional activities include serving on the music education faculty at the University of Minnesota, participating as a frequent adjudicator in the Colorado Regional and State Concert Band Festivals, and teaching seminars on conducting and music education at VanderCook College and Plymouth State University. She has enjoyed guest conducting high school and middle school honor bands in Minnesota, Wisconsin, Iowa, and Colorado. In April 2008, Jackson Kirchhoff was the guest conductor in residence at St. Olaf College while Dr. Timothy Mahr was completing his sabbatical. She is currently Past President of the Minnesota Band Directors Association and is conducting bands and teaching instrumental music at Eden Prairie High School in Eden Prairie, Minnesota.



Dr. Stephen Peterson was appointed Director of Bands at Ithaca College in Ithaca, New York, in 1998, where he currently conducts the Wind Ensemble and teaches courses in conducting and wind literature. From 1988-1998 he served as Associate Director of Bands at Northwestern University in Evanston, Illinois. Dr. Peterson was also Conductor of the renowned Northshore Concert Band. He served on the faculty at Stephen F. Austin State University in Nacogdoches, Texas and has several years of successful teaching experience in the public schools in Arizona. Dr. Peterson holds the Doctor of Music degree from Northwestern University and Master's and Bachelor's degrees from Arizona State University. His ensembles have appeared before conventions of the American Bandmaster's Association, the College Band Director's National Association, the National Association of College Wind and Percussion Instructors, the American School Band Director's Association, at Orchestra Hall with the Chicago Symphony Chorus, and at Lincoln Center. For many years Peterson served as a new music reviewer for The Instrumentalist Magazine, and is active as a conductor and clinician throughout the United States, Canada, Ireland, the Republic of China. He is a member of the Music Educator's National Conference, the College Band Directors National Association, the World Association of Symphonic Bands and Ensembles, The New York State Band Director's Association, the New York State School Music Association, and has been honored with membership in the prestigious American Bandmaster's Association.
