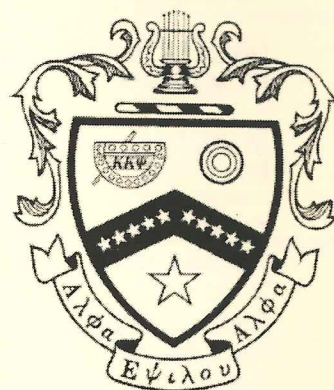

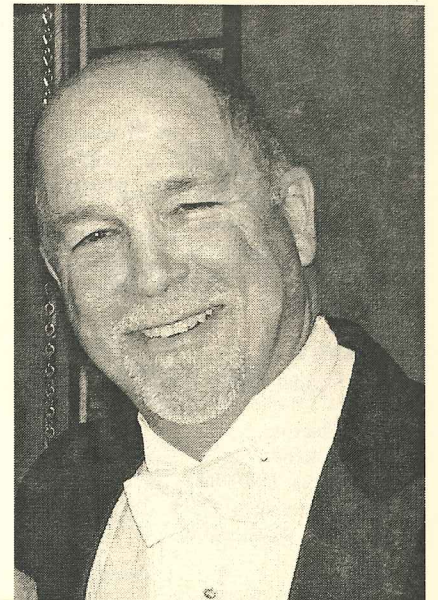

ALL-STATE BAND CLINICIANS

Dr. John R. Bell, Professor of Music and Director of Bands at Southern Illinois University Edwardsville, conducts the SIUE Wind Symphony and Chamber Winds, teaches conducting and music education courses, and coordinates recruiting and auditions for the Department of Music. He also is the Music Director of the St. Louis Brass Band.

Bell earned Doctors and Masters degrees from the University of Illinois and a Bachelor of Music Education degree from Louisiana State University where he served on the LSU Golden Band From Tigerland staff. He is a member of Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia, CBDNA, WASBE, ASBDA, MENC, and Pi Kappa Lambda Music Honor Society, and is a contributing author to the acclaimed series Teaching Music Through Performance in Band.

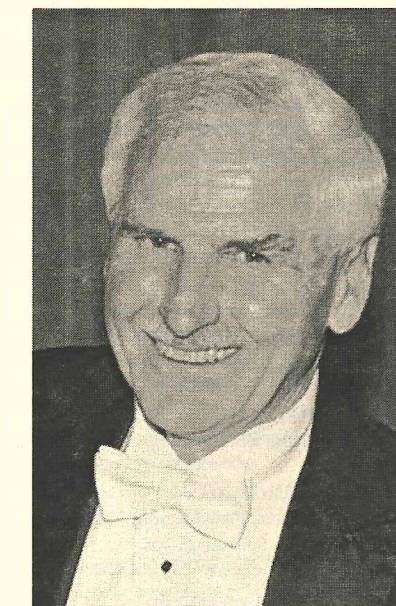
Under Dr. Bell's direction, The Southern Illinois Wind Symphony has premiered 13 works for wind band, toured Europe, performed twice in New York City's Carnegie Hall and for national meetings of the Music Educators National Conference, state meetings of the Illinois and Colorado Music Educators Associations, and divisional conferences of the North Central and Southwest Divisions of the College Band Directors National Association. Additionally, they have mounted six compact disc recording projects.



Ray E. Cramer holds a BA in Education, an MFA from the University of Iowa, an Honorary Doctorate from Western Illinois University, Vandercook College of Music, and in 2009 an Honorary Professorship at the Musashino Academy of Music in Tokyo. Prior to his appointment at Indiana University Mr. Cramer taught public school in Bardolph, Illinois, West Liberty, Iowa, Harlan, Iowa, and Parma, Ohio.

Ray E. Cramer was a member of the Indiana University School of Music faculty from the fall of 1969 through May 2005. In 1982, Mr. Cramer was appointed Director of Bands. Under his leadership the Indiana University Wind Ensemble earned an international reputation for outstanding musical performances. In addition to his administrative responsibilities as the Department of Bands/Wind Conducting Chair, Mr. Cramer taught graduate courses in wind conducting, history and literature. Mr. Cramer enjoyed a 36-year tenure at Indiana University with the final 24 years as Director of Bands.

He is a past National President of the College Band Directors National Association, The American Bandmasters Association and has served as president of the Indiana Bandmasters Association, the North Central Division of CBDNA and the Big Ten Band Directors Association. He is the current President of the Midwest Clinic, an international band and orchestra convention held in Chicago each December.
