Dr. Michael Golemo – Guest Conductor (Concert Band)

Michael Golemo has been the Director of Bands at Iowa State University since 1999. From 2005 to 2017, he also served as the Chair for the Department of Music & Theatre. In addition to conducting the Wind Ensemble and the Symphonic Band, he teaches courses in conducting and oversees a program of eleven bands.

Under his direction, the Iowa State University Wind Ensemble has performed five times for the Iowa Bandmasters Association conventions. They have performed in Chicago’s Orchestra Hall, Minneapolis’ Orchestra Hall and Omaha’s Holland Center for the Performing Arts. They have had eight performing tours in Europe. In 2016, the Wind Ensemble performed for the College Band Directors National Association and the National Band Association North Central Division Conference that was held at Iowa State.

A native of Chicago, he received his Bachelor of Music Education and Master of Music degrees from Northwestern University where he studied conducting with John Paynter and saxophone with Frederick Henke. He completed his doctorate in wind conducting at Michigan State University. He previously served as Assistant Director of Bands at The University of Akron (OH) and prior to that as Director of Bands at Albion College (MI).

With over 400 instrumental arrangements, transcriptions and compositions to his credit, Dr. Golemo has had works performed by a variety of performers and ensembles – from Carnegie Hall to Russia – including Wynton Marsalis, Anita Baker, the Akron Symphony Orchestra and the Des Moines Symphony Orchestra. His music is published by Ludwig Music Publishers, Dorn Publications, Santa Barbara Music Publishers, Daehn Publications (C.L. Barnhouse Company), Great Works Publishing, Alliance Music Publications, and Timeworks, LLC.

Dr. Golemo stays active nationally and internationally as a guest conductor, clinician and adjudicator. He has conducted all-state bands in Iowa, Texas, Nebraska, Louisiana, Idaho and New Mexico. He has served as the guest conductor for numerous honor bands at the middle school, high school and collegiate levels in the U.S. and in Japan. He has contributed articles to a variety of journals and publications including *The Instrumentalist*, *The Journal of the Association of Concert Bands*, *The Podium*, *The Journal of the North American Saxophone Alliance*, and *Teaching Music Through Performance in Band* (volumes 9 and 10).

He has received several notable awards, including the Iowa State College of Liberal Arts & Sciences’ Outstanding Achievement in Departmental Leadership Award, and Kappa Kappa Psi’s Distinguished Service to Music Medal, that organization’s highest honor. In 2022 he was awarded the distinguished title of “University Professor” at Iowa State University.

He is a past president of the Iowa Bandmasters Association, the Big Twelve Band Directors Association, and is a past National President and Board of Trustees member for Kappa Kappa Psi Honorary Band Fraternity. He serves on the Board of Directors for the John Philip Sousa Foundation and is chair of their Sudler Trophy Selection Committee.

He is the conductor of the Ames Municipal Band and in 2007, Dr. Golemo was elected to membership in the prestigious American Bandmasters Association.



Dr. Emily Threinen – Guest Conductor (Symphonic Band)

Emily Threinen is an Associate Professor of Music and serves as Director of Bands at the School of Music of the University of Minnesota-Twin Cities. In this position, she conducts the acclaimed University Wind Ensemble, guides the graduate wind band conducting program, and provides administrative leadership for all aspects of the University of Minnesota-TC Band Program. Threinen began this post in 2016.

Prior to her appointment at Minnesota, Threinen served as Associate Professor, Director of Bands, and Artistic Director of Winds and Brass at Temple University’s Boyer College of Music and Dance in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. Before her work in Philadelphia, Threinen served as Assistant Professor, Director of Bands at Shenandoah Conservatory of Shenandoah University in Winchester, Virginia; Director of the Duke University Wind Symphony in Durham, North Carolina; Director of the Concordia University Wind Ensemble in Ann Arbor, Michigan; Conductor of the Dodworth Saxhorn Band in Ann Arbor, Michigan; and Director of Bands and Instrumental Music at Harding High School in St. Paul, Minnesota, where she received the Outstanding Teacher Award.

Threinen consistently works with composers, arrangers, and performing artists of varied disciplines. Residencies, projects with composers, and new compositions are integral to her creative work. Threinen has been published in multiple volumes of the GIA “Teaching Music Through Performance in Band” book series, where she has been recognized as a strong scholarly contributor. She is active across the nation and abroad (including appearances in Australia, Spain, Brazil, and Canada), as a guest conductor, clinician, and conference presenter. In 2023, Threinen was a guest conductor and clinician for the U.S. Army Band “Pershing’s Own” Conductors Workshop and in 2019, Threinen was the conductor for the National Association for Music Education All-National High School Concert Band at the National Conference in Orlando, Florida.

Threinen is a strong advocate for music education and is proud to serve as a Yamaha Master Educator. She is an active member of these organizations: American Bandmasters Association (ABA), World Association for Symphonic Band and Ensembles (WASBE), College Band Directors National Association (CBDNA), Big Ten Band Directors Association, National Band Association (NBA), National Association for Music Education (NAfME), and Pi Kappa Lambda and Kappa Kappa Psi as an honorary member.

Threinen is a native of Minnesota and a graduate of the University of Minnesota-Twin Cities (1999), Northwestern University in Evanston, Illinois (2004), and the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor, Michigan (2007). She and her family live in a suburb outside of Minneapolis, Minnesota.
