

## Colorado All-State Band Re-Audition Information 2024

1. Your director will give you a sheet with the specific measures you need to play. Be sure to find your name and record those measures from YOUR PART on each song. If you see N/A you are not required to include that song.
  - a. You can record each element separately, but you must combine them into a single .mp3 that will be emailed to your band director for submission.
  - b. You are encouraged to use the best recording equipment you have access to for the best results. Percussion should do AUDIO recordings (Video is not required for re-auditions).
  - c. All students are expected to submit a recording. Those instruments that are not auditioning for chairs (piccolo, English horn, percussion, etc.) are still expected to submit a recording that will be evaluated to make sure all students are on track with their preparations for a great weekend.
    - i. Any student that does not submit a recording will be placed at the back of the section, and will have two more weeks to get their re-audition done. See #2 below
  - d. Recordings should be combined in the following order:
    - i. Introduction (Students name, school name and instrument)
    - ii. Excerpts (in the order 2A, 2B, 2C, 2D, 2E, 2F [Symphonic band])

    - iii. Percussion should perform on the correct instrument(s) as is possible, using the sticks/mallets they are planning on using at the weekend.
  - e. Recordings should be named: Instrument\_Band\_Last Name.mp3
  - f. Recordings should be emailed to your band director who will submit it for you. Remember, they must ALSO submit your student registration or your re-audition will not be evaluated. Be sure you have completed this form for your director.
  - g. Directors must have them uploaded by 5:00pm on Sunday, February 25 – Be sure to follow their instructions so they have time to get them uploaded
2. Students who do not submit a recording, or submit a recording, but are considered unprepared will receive an email (cc'd to their director) with the expectation to work with their director and/or private teacher before the weekend to ensure their success. You will need to send in a follow-up recording in two weeks and if you are still considered unprepared, you will be removed from the group and an alternate will be called up.
3. The lunch on Saturday (provided) consists of traditional pizza (including cheese, vegetarian and various meats) and drinks. IF YOU HAVE A DIETARY CONCERN that would make it impossible to eat, you MUST fill out the Dietary form (in the members section of the Web-Site) to let us know so we can get something you will be able to eat. Only students with dietary concerns should fill out this form.
4. All members of the All-State Band will receive an All-State Band patch (complements of the University of Northern Colorado). You may choose to order an All-State medal (not required) to help celebrate your success. Information is in the parent section and member section of the web-site
5. MDS Audio will record the concert. You may pre-order a recording and avoid standing in line at the concert, or you may order in person at the event (not required). MDS recommends that you pre-order to save you time. Complete information is available in the parent and member section of the web-site
